

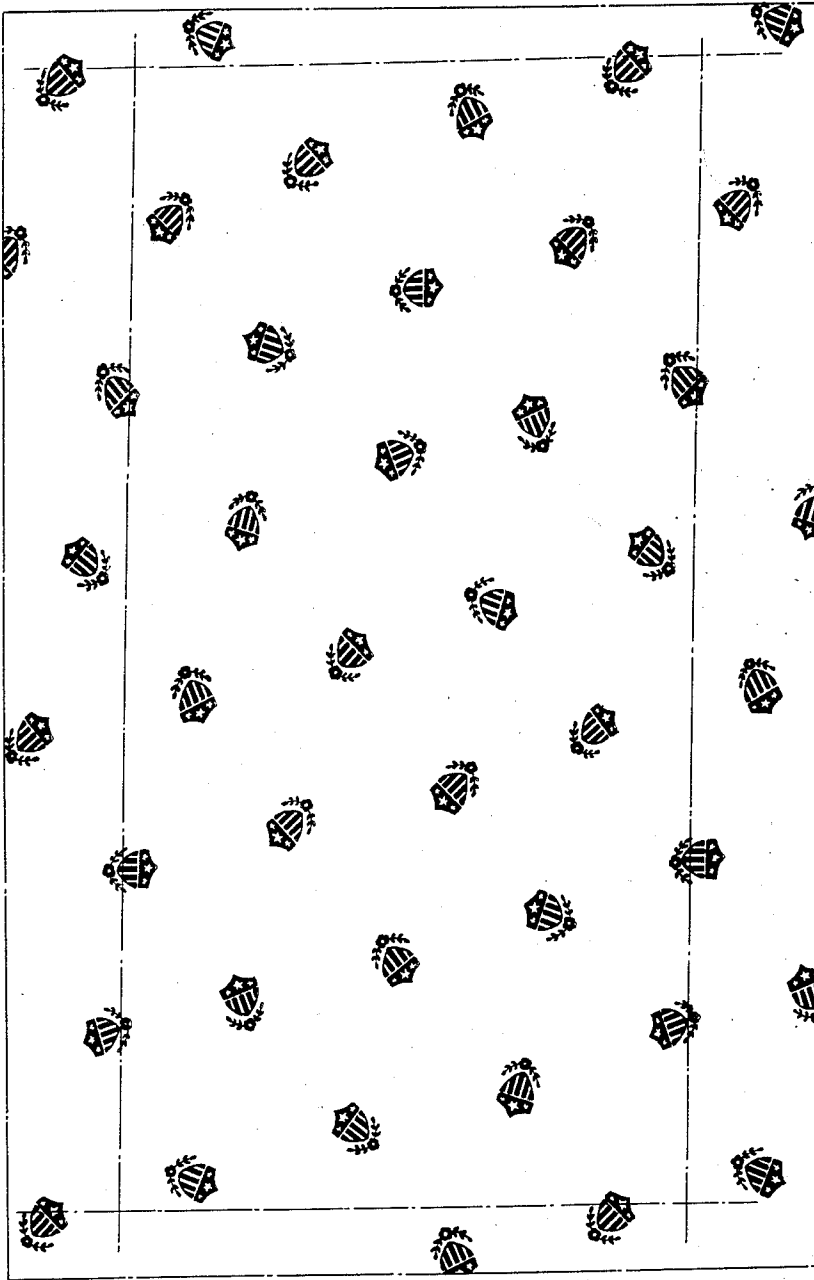

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Sanford Z. Kaye, a citizen of the United States, residing at Manhasset, Long Island, New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design.

The design unit is contained between the dot and dash lines, which unit is repeated in regular succession as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric, substantially as shown and described.
