DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and left side perspective view of a double eyelid formation tape;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image of the front elevational view shown;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of the right side elevational view shown;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being a mirror image of the top plan view shown;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged partial front elevational view thereof, taken along the section indicated by the dot-dash broken line rectangle 5 in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 6 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof, taken along lines 6-6 in FIG. 2.

The evenly spaced broken lines in the drawings illustrate subject matter that forms no part of the claimed design. The dot-dash broken lines in the drawings depict the limits of the enlarged view of FIG. 5 and form no part of the claimed design.

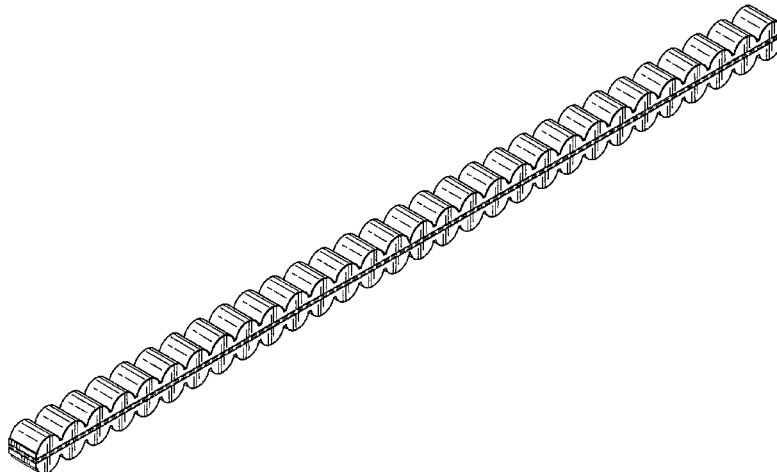

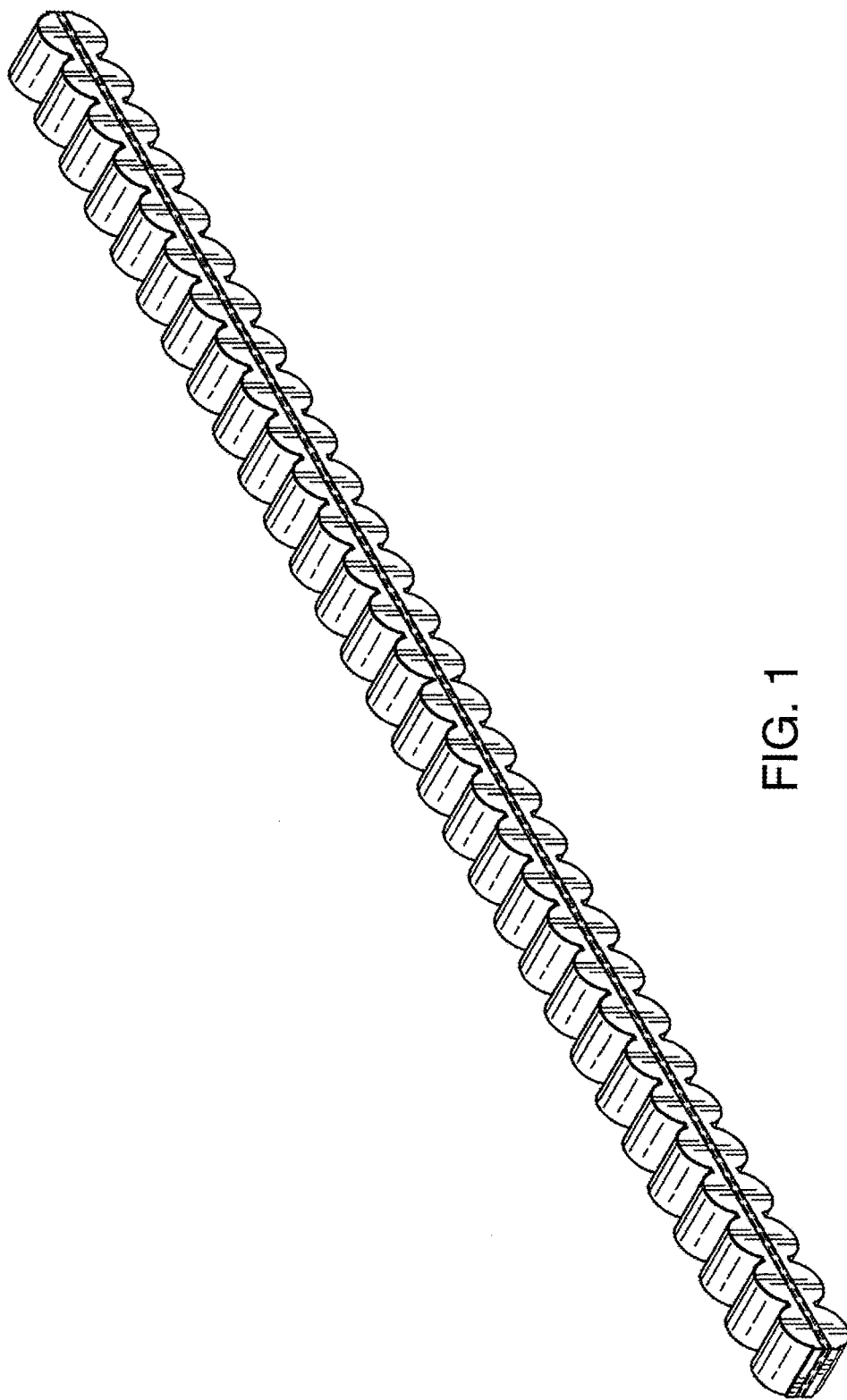
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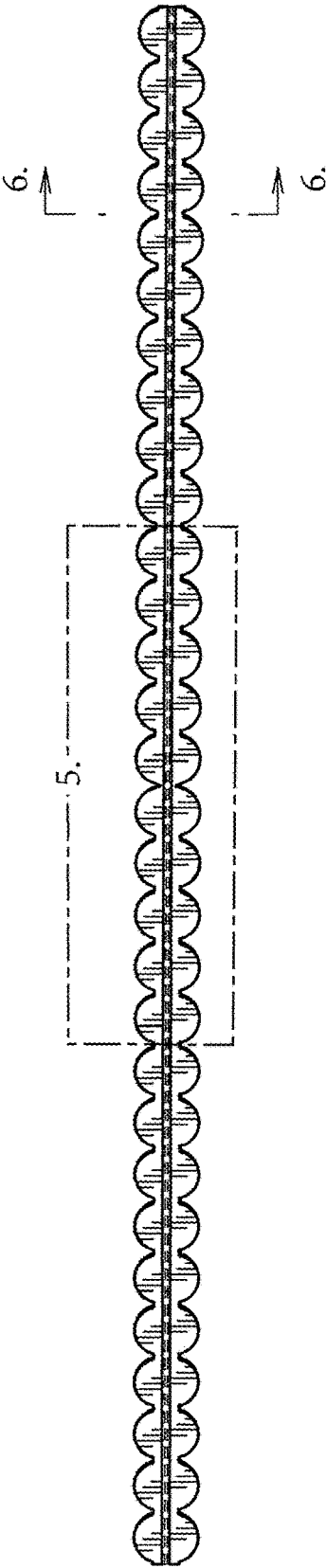

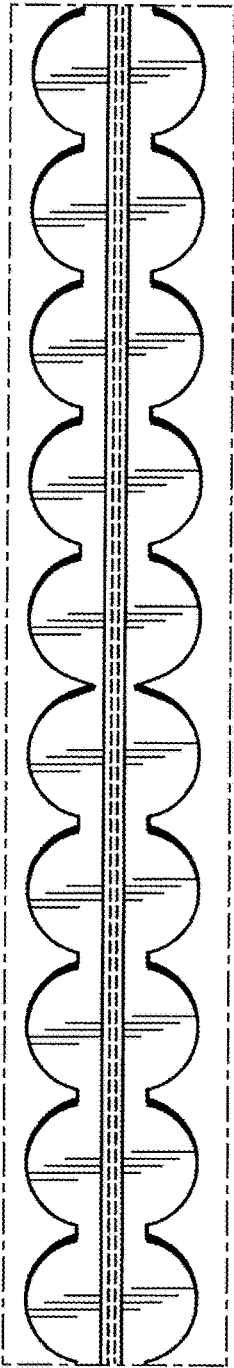

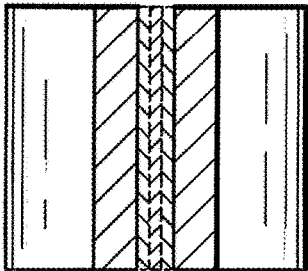
