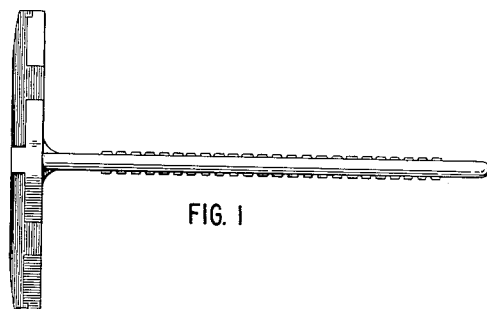

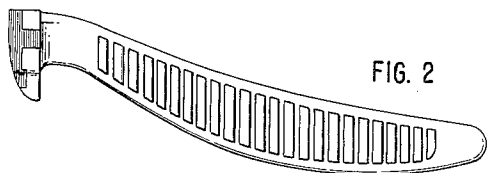

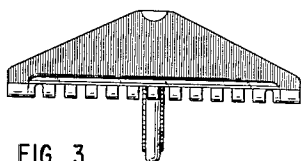

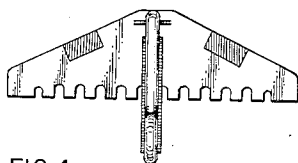

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a disposable razor showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the right of FIG. 2.

The essential feature of the design resides in the configuration of the razor head in combination with the handle which is shaped as shown. The drawing is lined to indicate an optional color contrast.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a disposable razor, substantially as shown and described.
