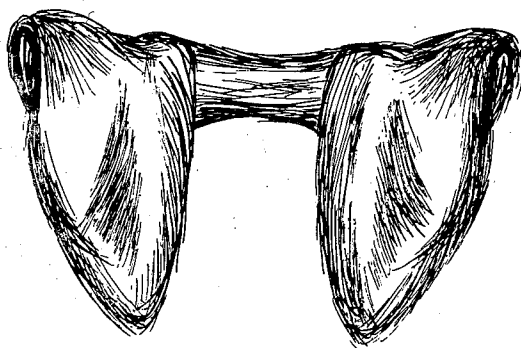

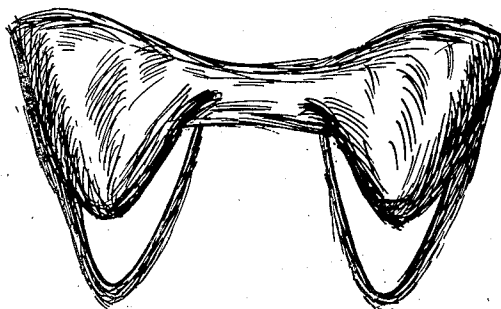

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jacob A. Silverman, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, in the Borough of Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fur Collar, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein,
