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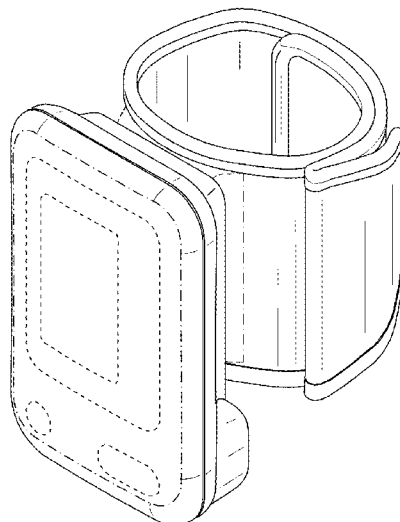
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the sphygmomanometer; FIG. 2 is a rear view of the sphygmomanometer; FIG. 3 is an end view of the sphygmomanometer; FIG. 4 is an opposite end view of the sphygmomanometer; FIG. 5 is a right side view of the sphygmomanometer; FIG. 6 is a left side view of the sphygmomanometer; and, FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the sphygmomanometer. 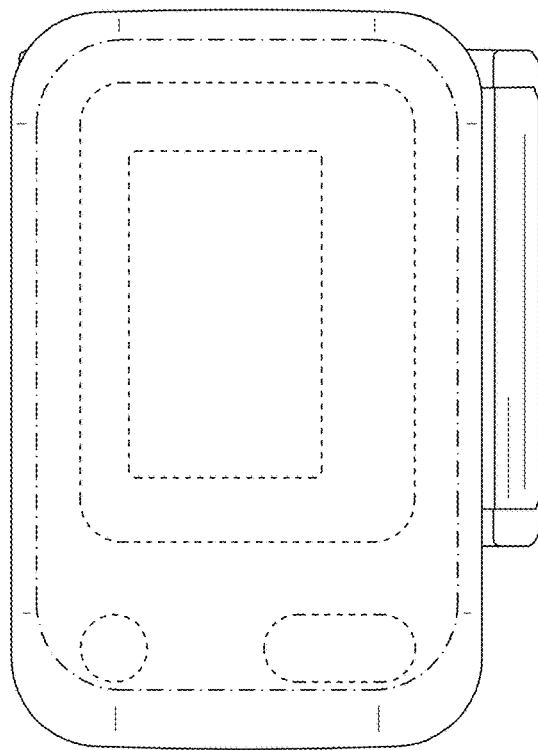

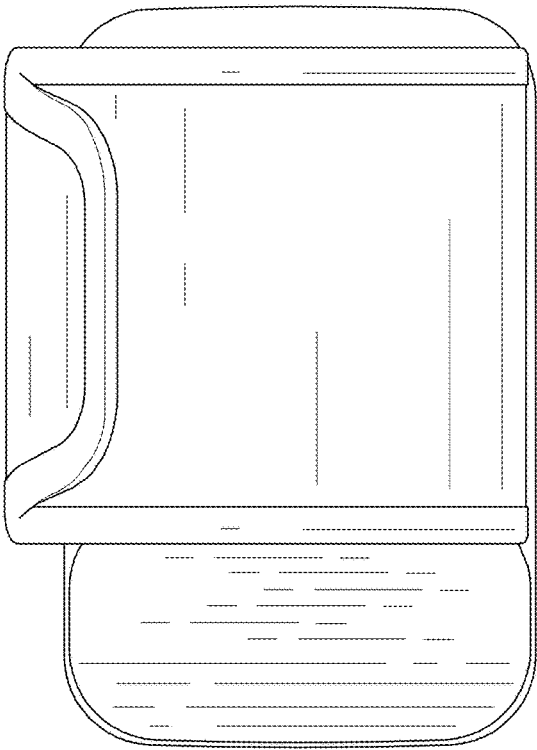

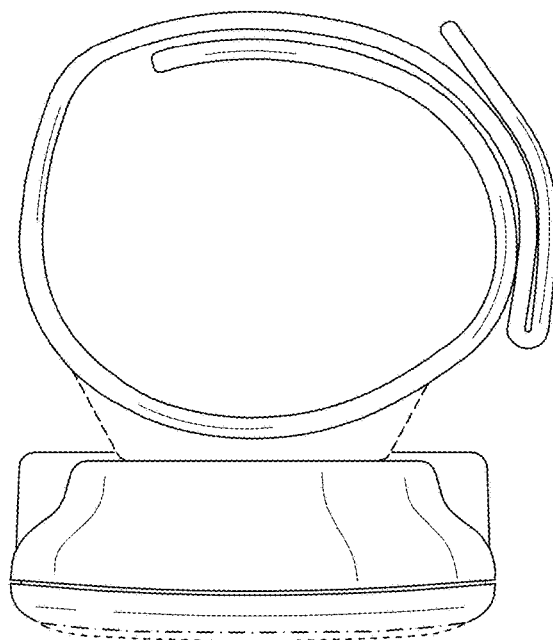

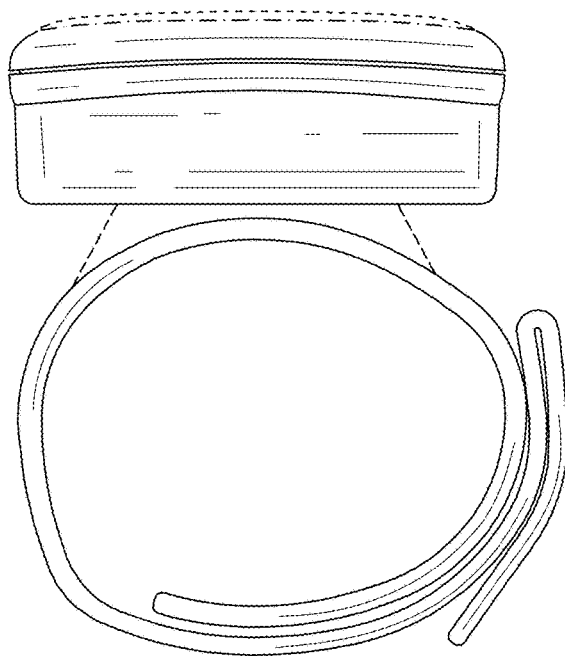

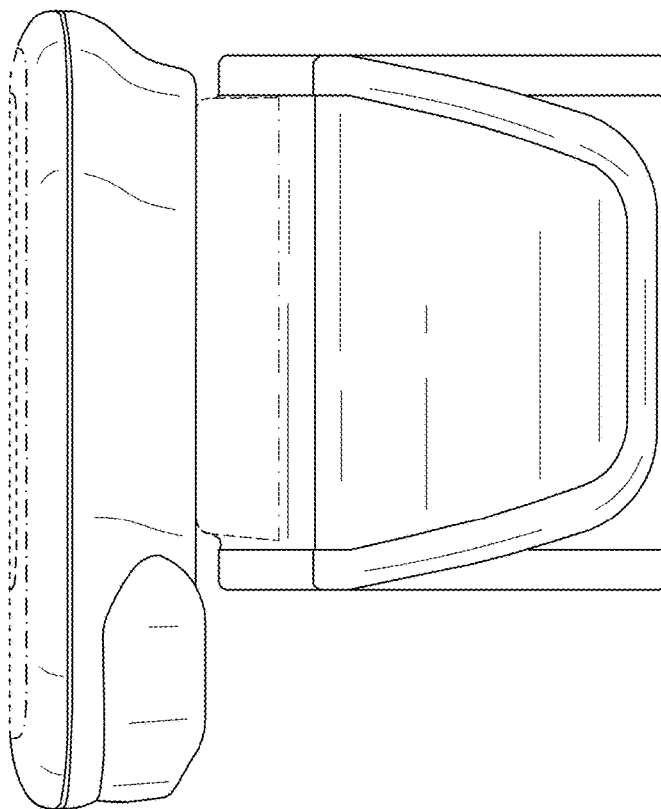

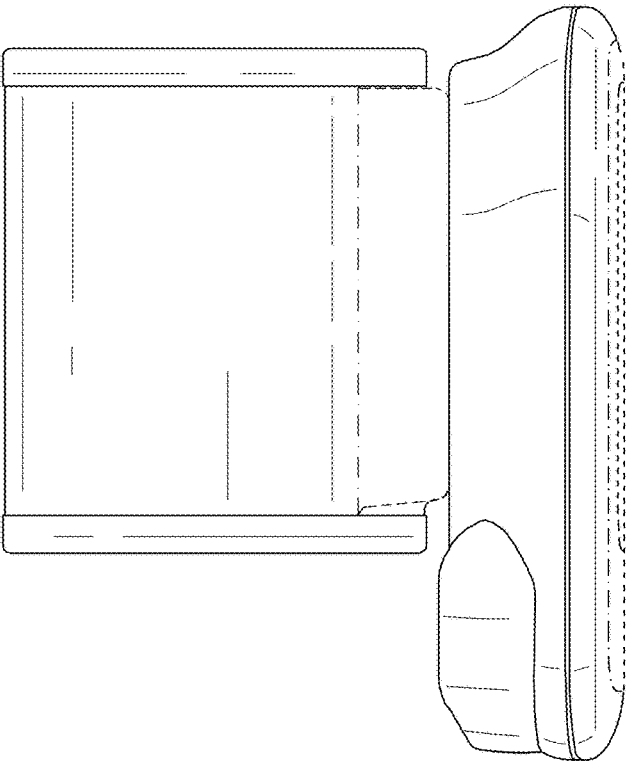

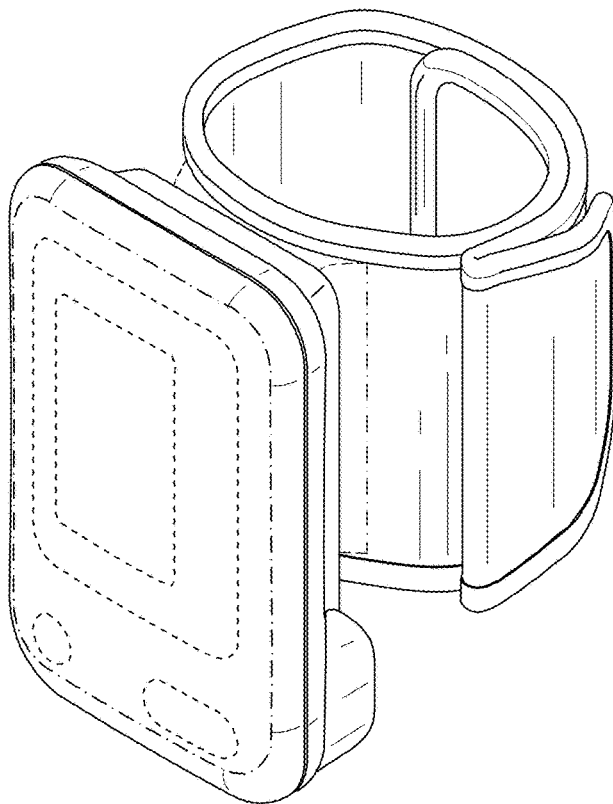
