


DESIGN FOR A CANDY PACKAGE

Application filed September 29, 1932. Serial No. 45,162. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH HAAN, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Manhattan, county, city, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Candy Package, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 illustrates in perspective a candy package showing my new design; and Figure 2 is a view seen from above.
