


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK C. MORRELL, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental design for an Electric-Light Hanger-Fixture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawings, in Figure 1, in perspective, is shown the particular shape or formation as well as ornamental character of the hanger-fixture having a depending bell-shaped porcelain socket of my new design

for the reception of the electric bulb; and Fig. 2, is an underneath plan view of the socket of my said new design not fully disclosed in Fig. 1 and arranged when the electric bulb is secured thereinto, the bulb only is exposed beyond the bell-shape of said socket.

I claim:—

The ornamental design for an electric-light hanger-fixture, substantially as shown and described.
