To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Sylvester G. Lipic, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of St. Louis and State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pencil or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing,

Fig. 1 is an elevational view of a pencil embodying my new design as it appears in a vertical position;

Fig. 2 is a longitudinal sectional view of the capsule portion thereof on an enlarged scale;

Fig. 3 is an elevational view illustrating the appearance of the pencil shown in Fig. 1 when in a horizontal position.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines on the drawing.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pencil or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
