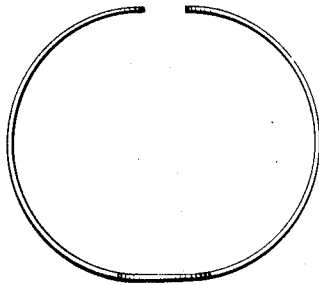

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM M. STOCKMAN, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bracelet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
