FIG. 4 is a front view of the fishing lure charging light illustrated in FIG. 1.

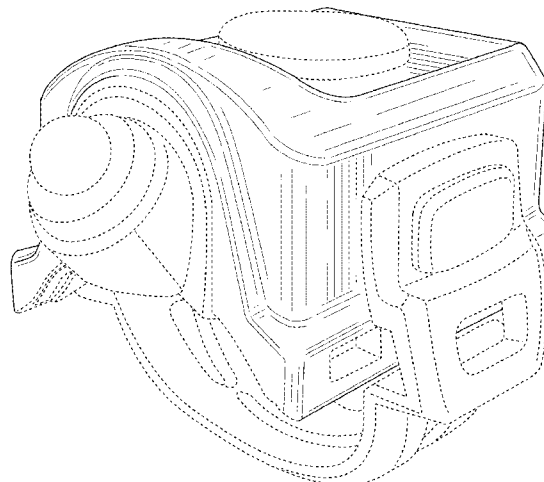
FIG. 5 is rear view of the fishing lure charging light illustrated in FIG. 1.

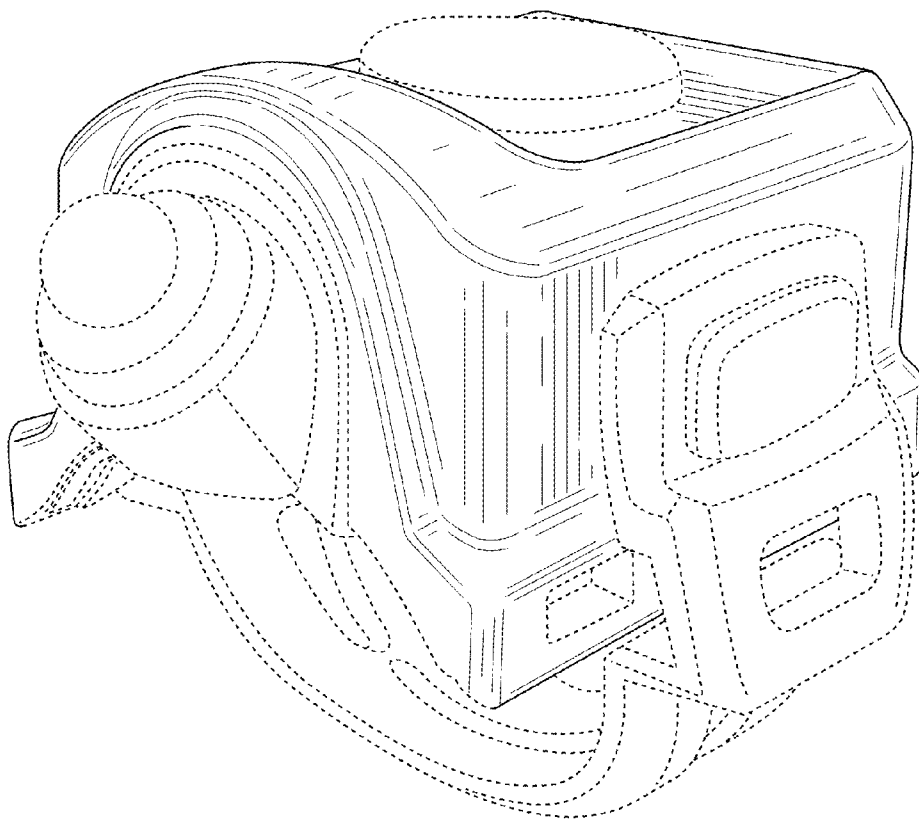

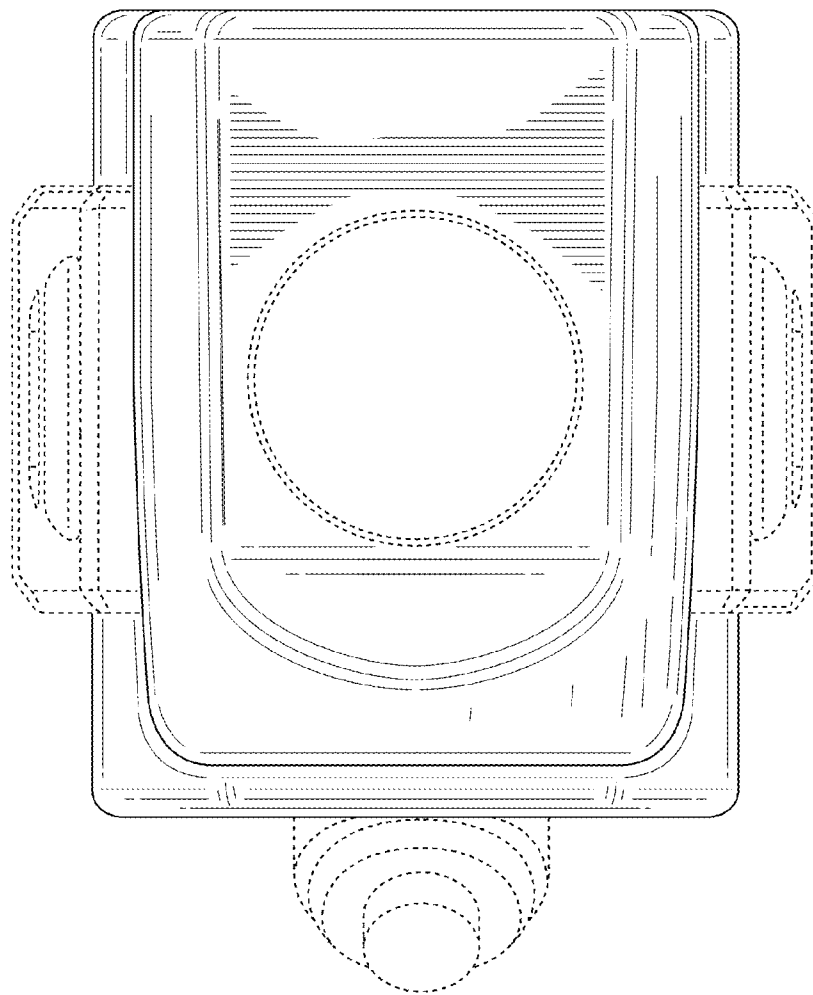

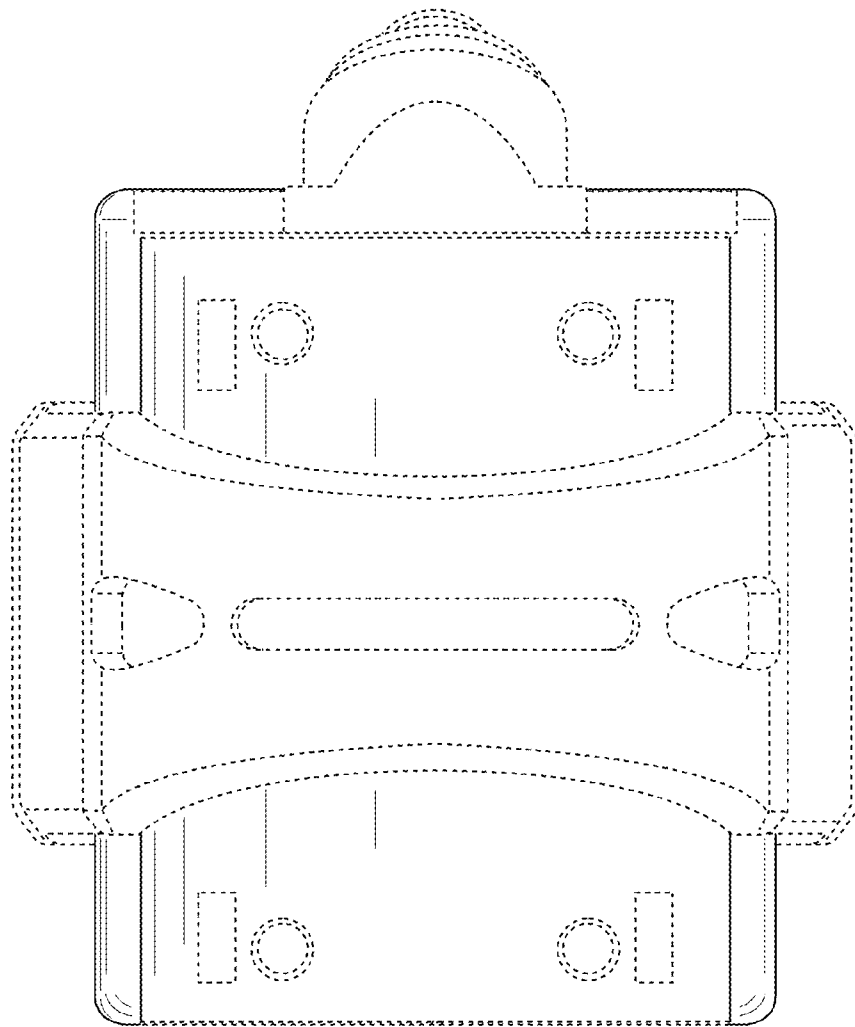

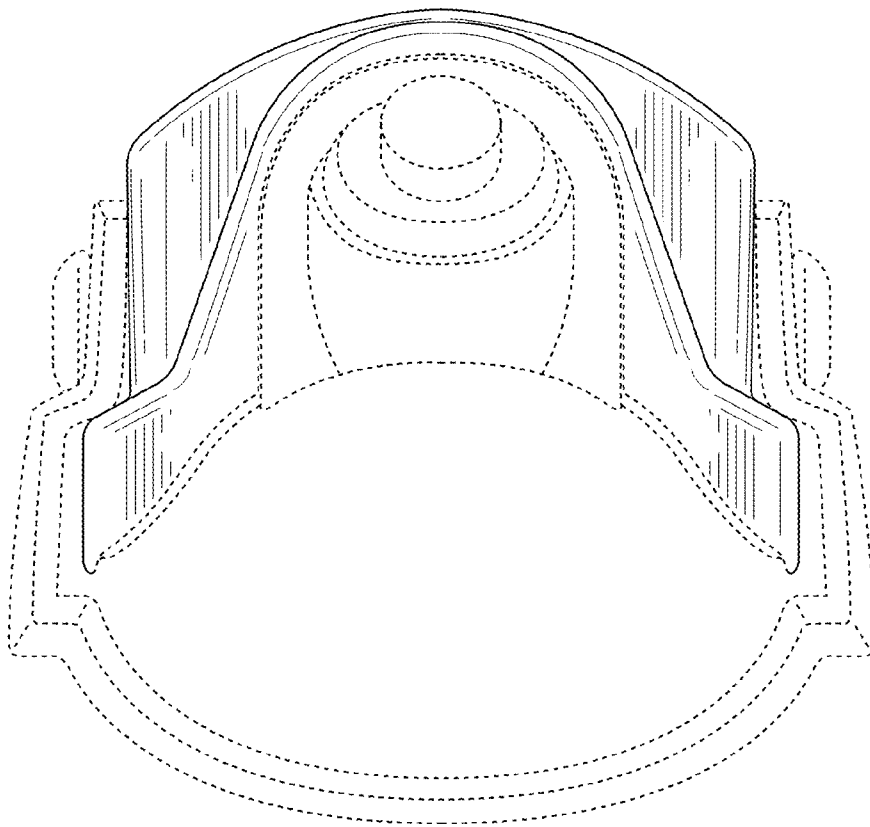

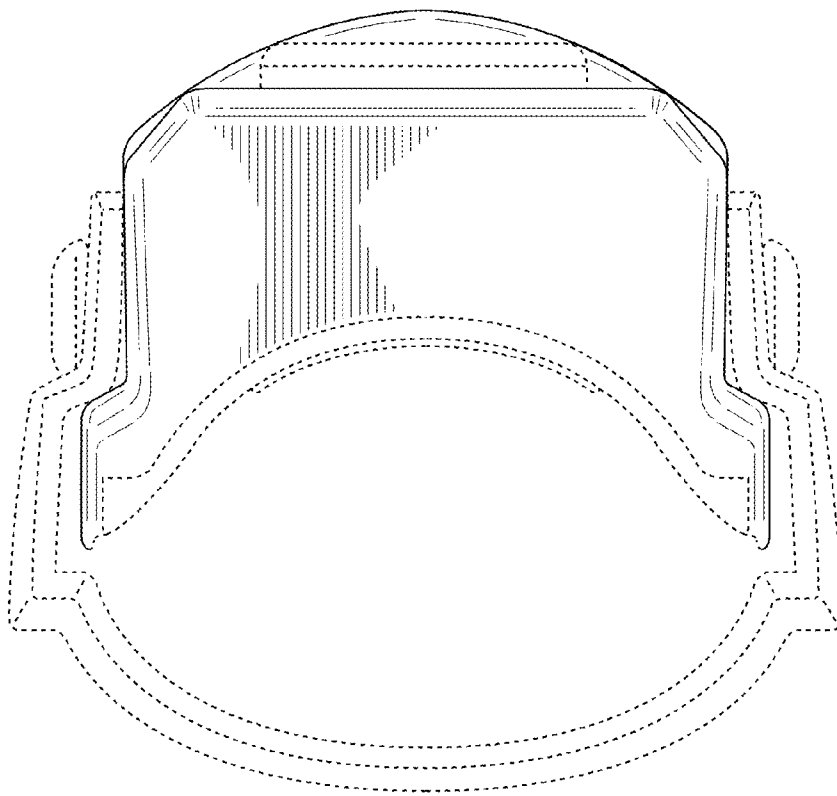

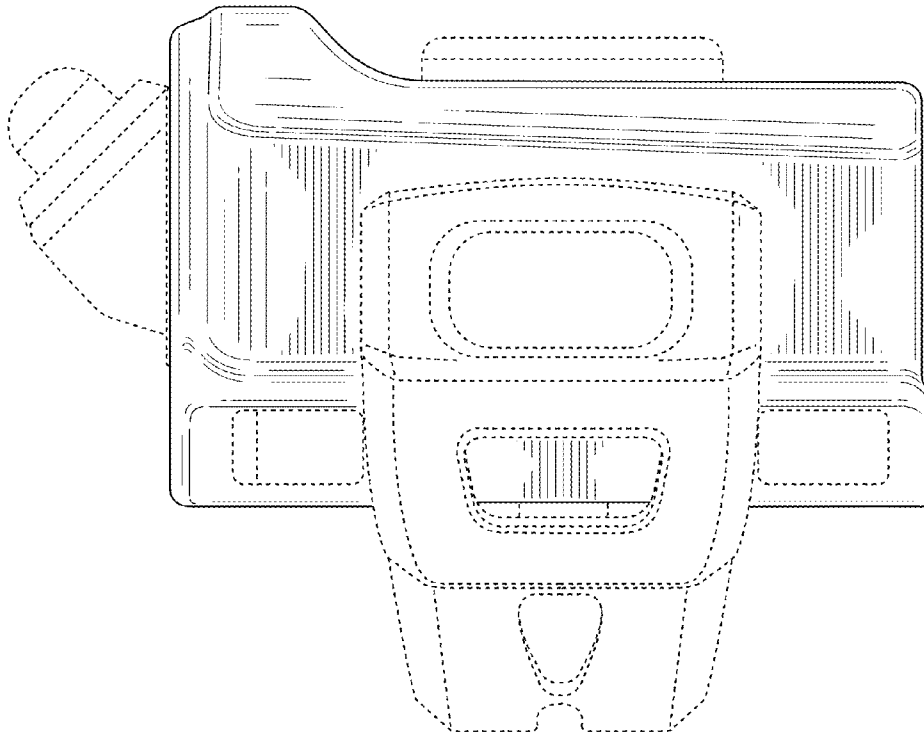

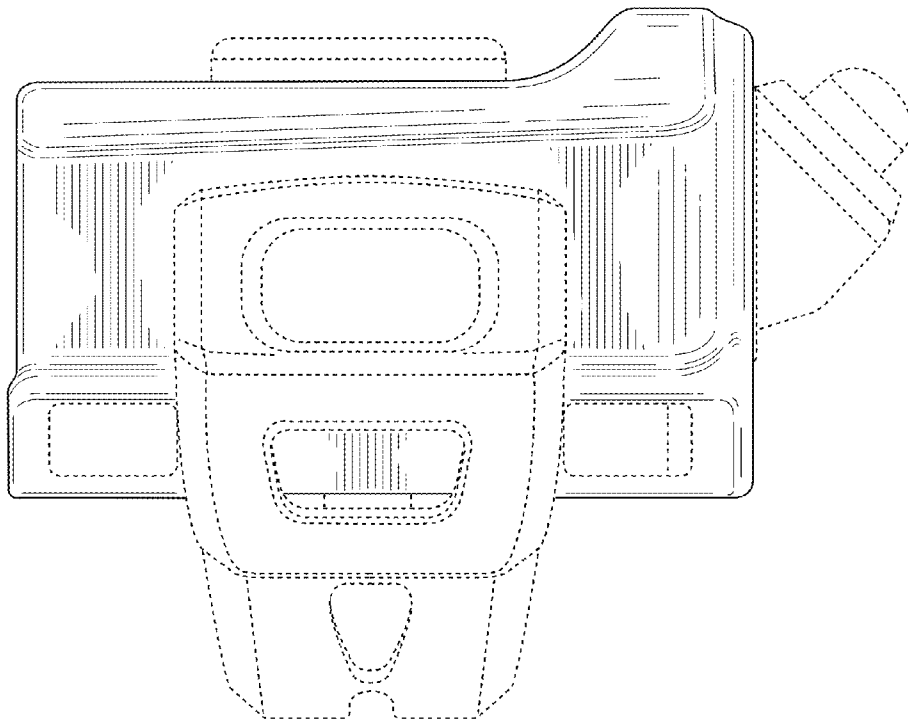
