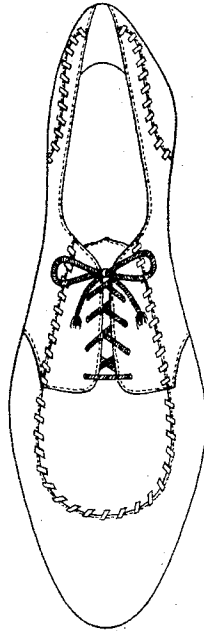

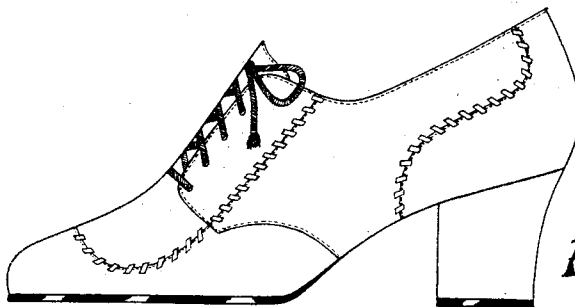

DESIGN FOR A SHOE

Application filed November 11, 1932. Serial No. 45,887. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES MILLER, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
