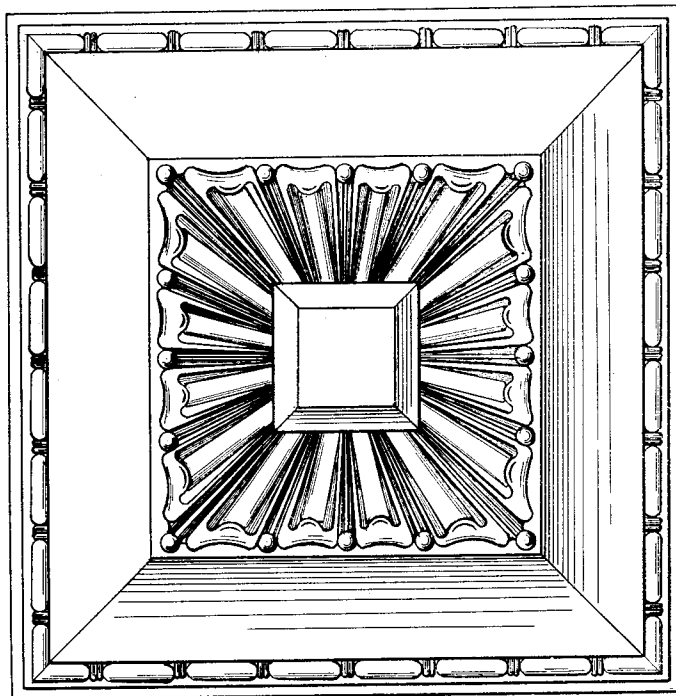

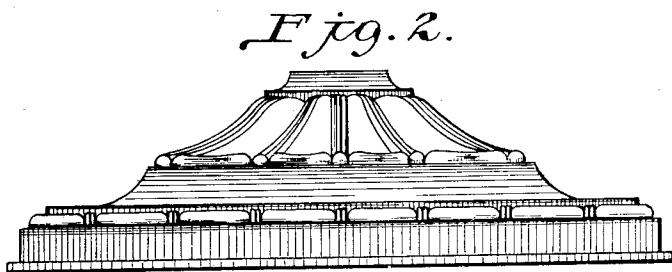

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HARRISON D. McFADDIN, a citizen of the United States, residing in East Orange, county of Essex, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shell for Lighting-Fixtures and Analogous Devices, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the design for a shell for lighting fixtures and analogous devices, and Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof.
