

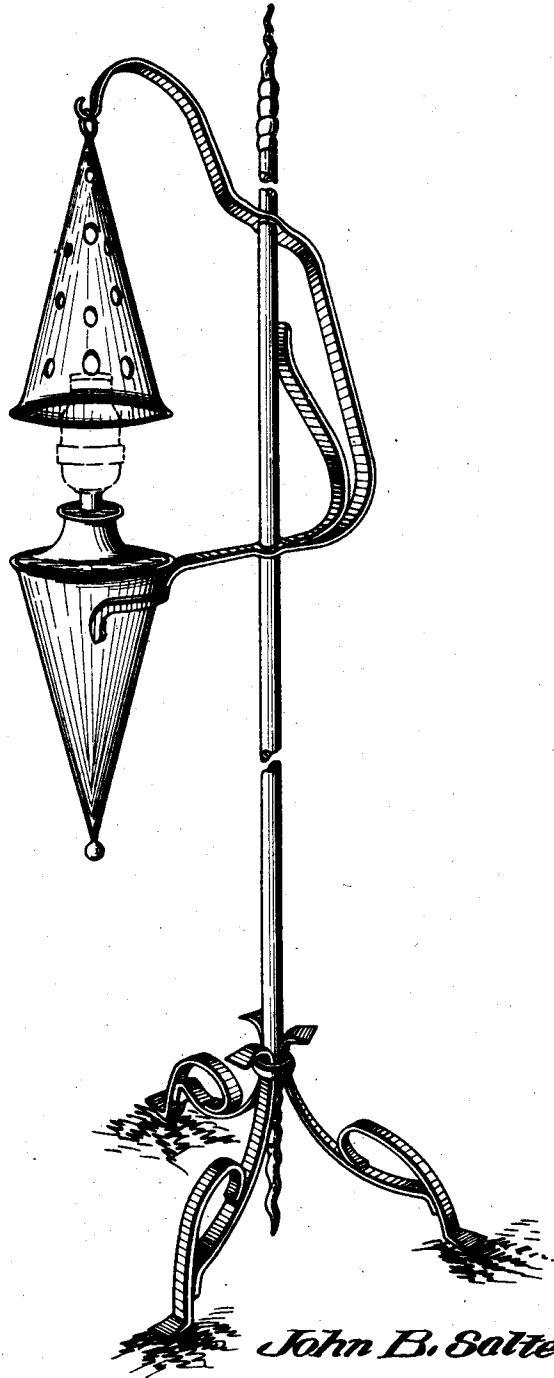

DESIGN FOR A BRIDGE LAMP.

Application filed March 2, 1929. Serial No. 30,287. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN B.
