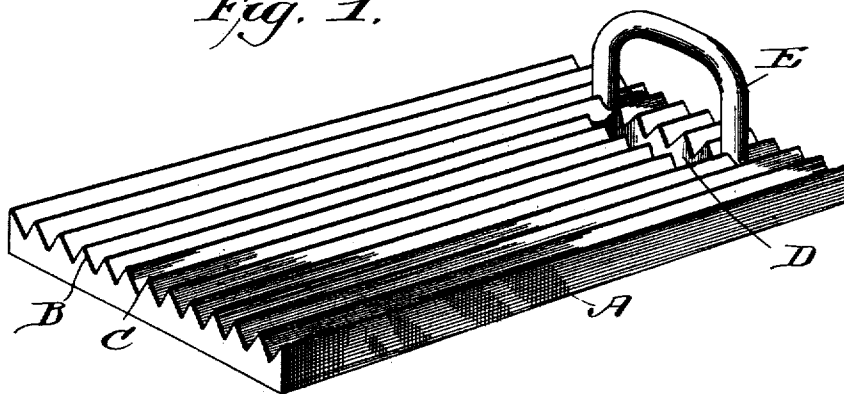
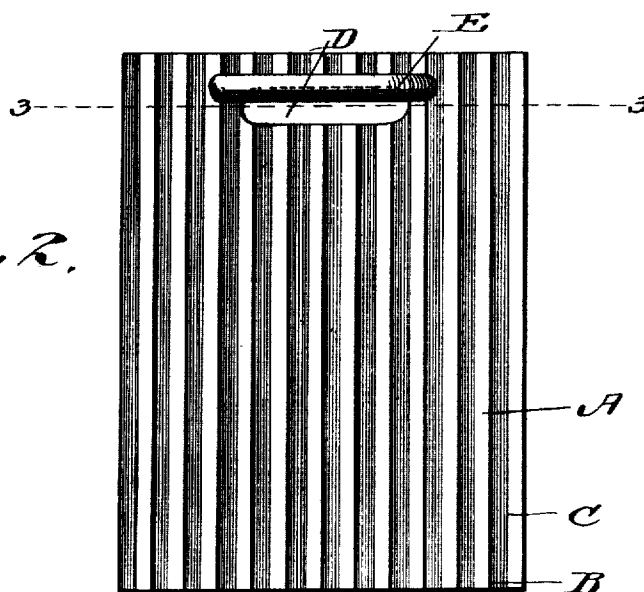
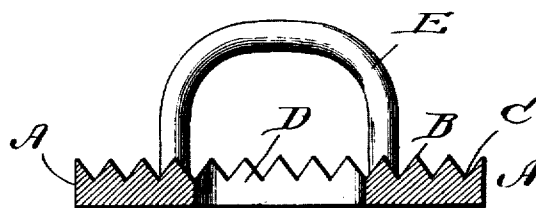

ASA MOODY, OF HAWARDEN, IOWA.

DESIGN FOR A BROILER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 33,105, dated August 21, 1900.

Application filed July 14, 1900. Serial No. 23,680. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ASA MOODY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Hawarden, in the county of Sioux and State of Iowa, have invented and produced a new and useful Design for a Broiler, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a broiler constructed in accordance with my invention. Fig. 2 is a face view of the same, and Fig. 3 is a detail sectional view on the line 3 3 of Fig. 2.

The essential feature of my invention consists in the peculiar formation of the upper surface, together with the shape and arrangement of the handle.

Describing my design in detail, A repre-

sents a plate, the lower face being smooth, while the upper face is ridged or corrugated, 20 as shown, the ridges being indicated by the letter B and the depressions by the letter C. Near one end of the plate is a circular opening D, and a handle E, curved as shown, extends upwardly from the ridged or corrugated 25 face of the plate and extends over the opening D.

Having thus fully described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a broiler, substantially as 30 herein shown and described.
