

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a support stand for dishes or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a support stand for dishes or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a fragmentary elevational view of one corner thereof; and FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; the bottom plan view being substantially similar thereto.








