

DESIGN FOR A SAW SET AND GAGE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 33,333, dated October 9, 1900.

Application filed August 29, 1900. Serial No. 28,480. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEWIS VALENTINE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Claquato, in the county of Lewis and State of Washington, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Saw Set and Gage, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which—
10 Figure 1 is a perspective view of my invention. Fig. 2 is a face view showing it from the opposite side, and Fig. 3 is a cross-section on the line 3 3 of Fig. 1.

15 The leading feature of the design is the form of the handle portion *a*, the same being oblong

and rounded, so that taken as a whole it is approximately egg-shaped. The smaller end of such oblong or rounded portion is square or flat, and the base portion *b* is also flat and provided with projections *c*.

Having described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a saw set and gage, substantially as shown and described.
