C. L. HAMMOND, OF NORTH JAVA, NEW YORK.

IMPROVED MEDICINE FOR HORSES.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 59,216, dated October 30, 1866.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, C. L. HAMMOND, of North Java, in the county of Wyoming and State of New York, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Medicines for the Cure of Galls, Scratches, Ringbone, Spavins, and other Diseases of Horses and Beasts, as well as the Cure of Venereal Diseases in Man; and do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

My invention consists in the admixture of the following ingredients, and in the manner specified: To one (1) pint of turpentine add one (1) pint of linseed oil, one (1) ounce of origanum, and two (2) ounces of oil of vitriol. In mixing these ingredients, the oil of vitriol should be placed in last and mixed in an open dish or vessel.

Directions: Wet the diseased parts with saleratus-water, and then apply the smallest amount of the medicine. What will adhere to the finger's end will answer for a gall as large as a dollar. For deep sores the medicine should be applied with a syringe.

Having thus fully described my invention, what I claim is—

The above-described ingredients, mixed as specified, and for the purposes set forth.
