




DESIGN FOR A CLIP.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES C. GEBHARDT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Richmond, in the county of Henrico and State of Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Clips, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view looking at one face of a clip, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a perspective view looking at another face thereof; and Fig. 3 is a side elevation of the clip.
