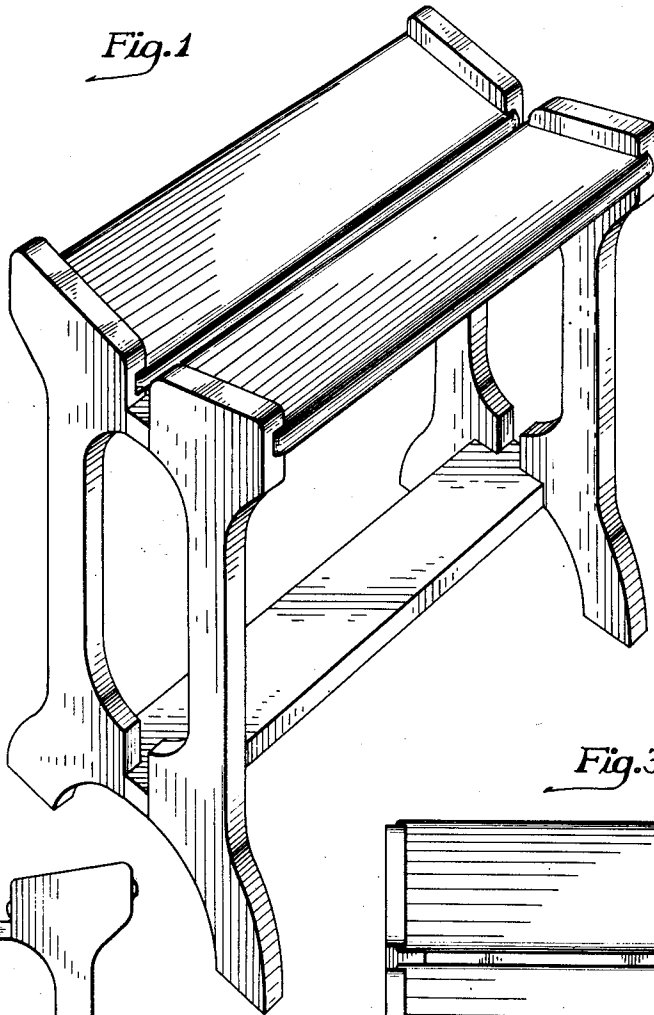

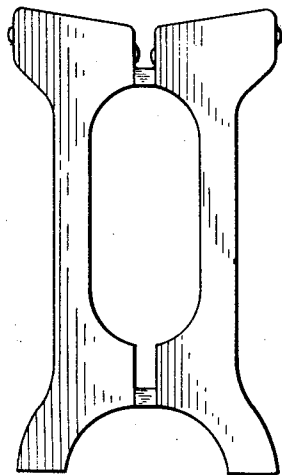
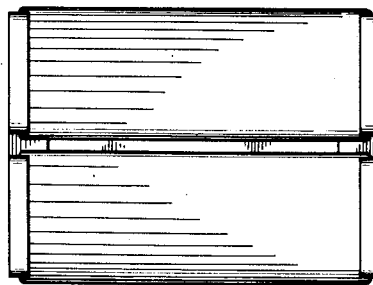

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph A. Mors, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Seat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a seat, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an end elevational view of the same on a reduced scale.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view of the same on a reduced scale.
