


CLAIM

[57] The ornamental design for a portable electric heater, substantially as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a portable electric heater showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof. The conventional electrical cord has been shown fragmentary in FIGS. 2 and 4 for ease of illustration.




