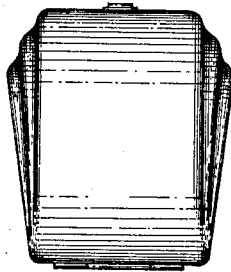

DESIGN FOR A VANITY CASE
