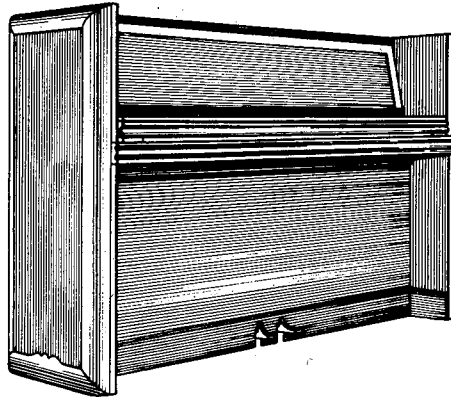

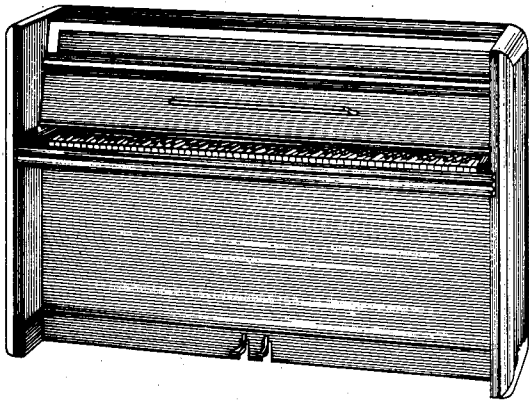

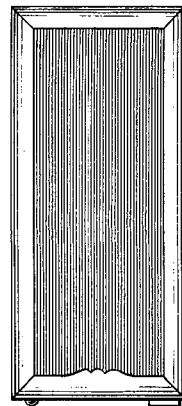

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Thomas J. Dentz, a citizen of the United States, residing at the Borough of Manhattan, in the city of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Piano Case, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
