

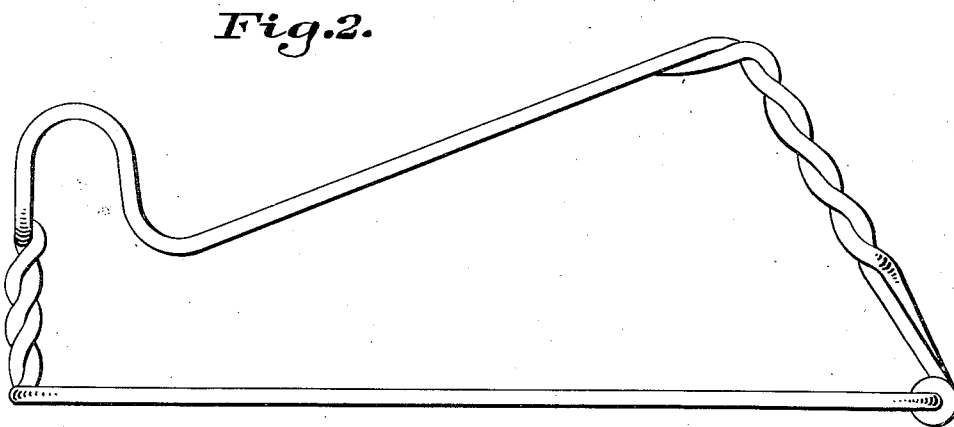
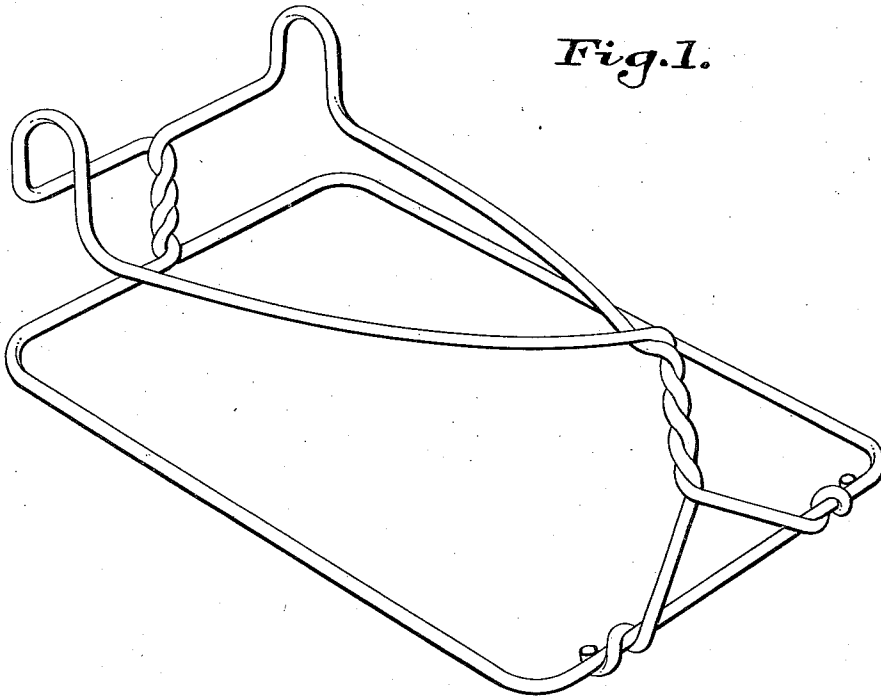

DESIGN FOR A FLATIRON REST

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles H. Nesbitt, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Birmingham, in the county of Jefferson and State of Alabama, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Flatiron Rests, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a flatiron rest showing my new design, and

Figure 2 is a side elevation.
