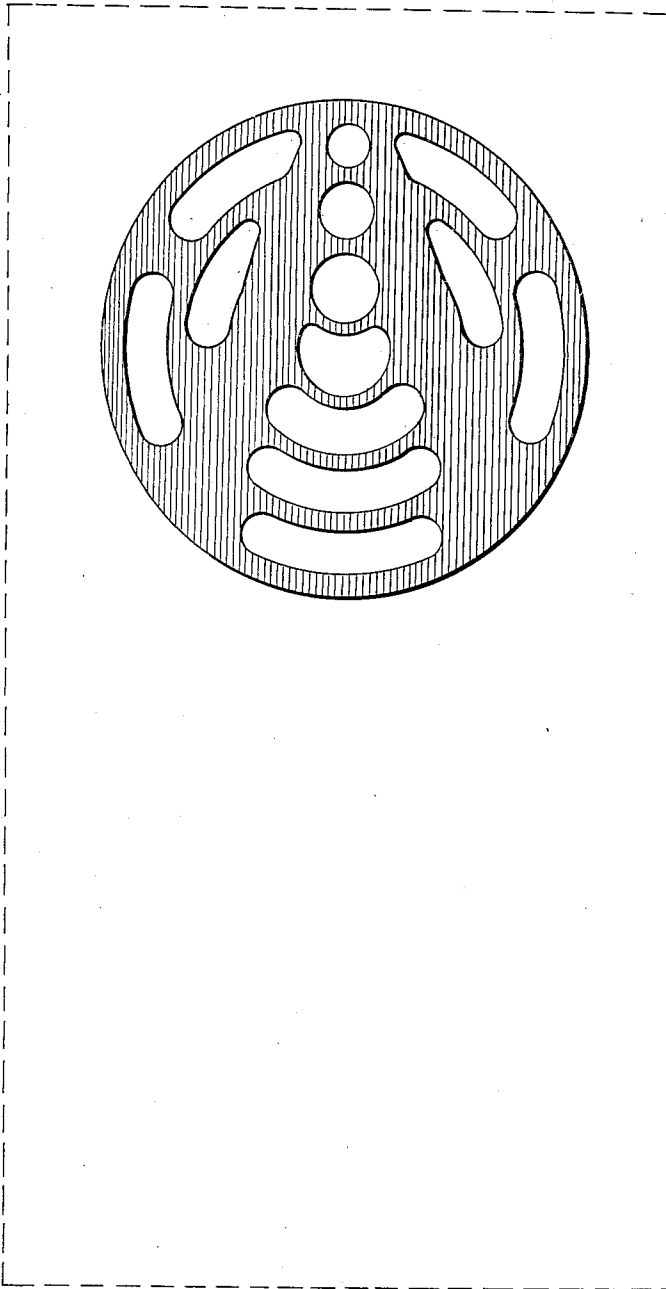

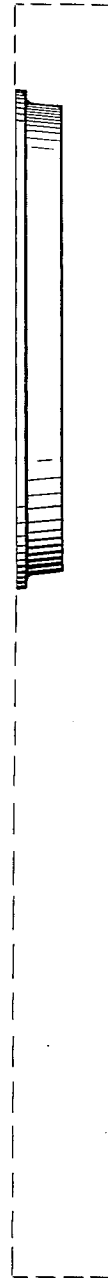

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Howard J. Peo, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Monroe and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Game Board, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of the game board, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation thereof.

The dominant feature of this design resides in the part shown in full lines.
