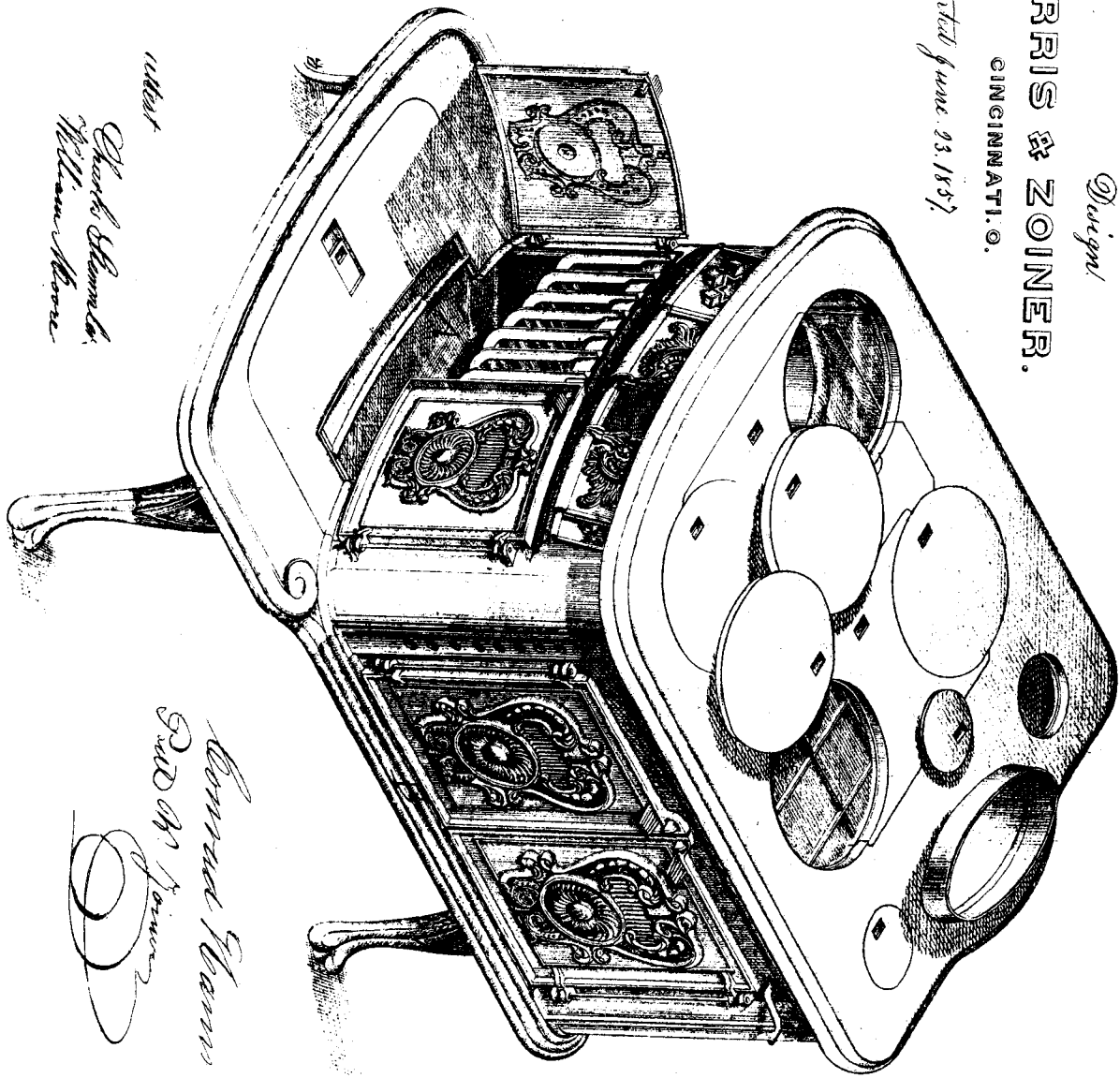

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To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Conrad Harris, and Paul Wm. Joiner, both of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new and useful design for Coal burning Stoves, and we do hereby declare the following to be a full, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the annexed drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon - in which letter A, represents the front of the stove and letter B, the side of the stove.

What we claim as our invention, and desire to secure by letters patent is the configuration and arrangement of the several ornaments as set forth in the annexed drawings forming a new and original design for Coal burning Stoves to be known and called the Tropic.
