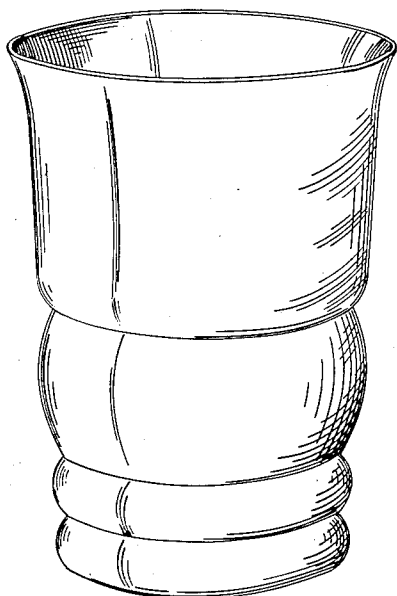

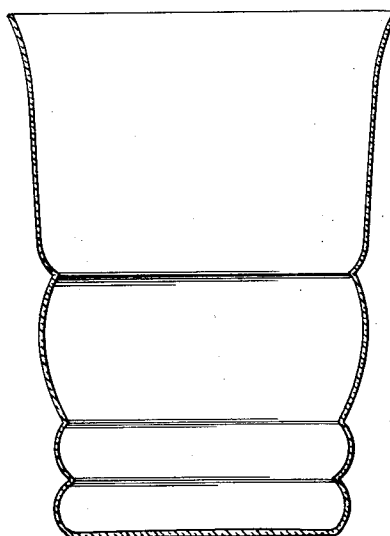

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John B. Boehm, a citizen of the United States, residing at Morgantown, Monongalia county, West Virginia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tumbler, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying
