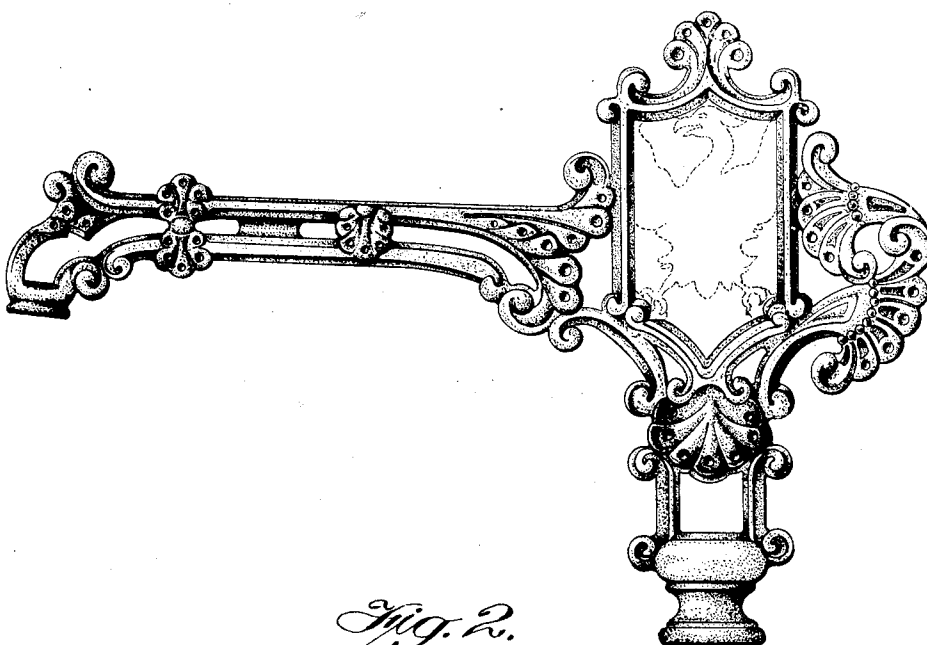
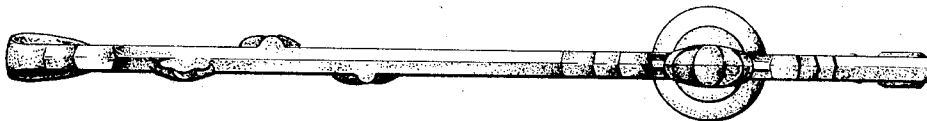

DESIGN FOR A LAMP BRACKET.

Application filed December 27, 1927. Serial No. 24,659. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ERNEST KLOPFSTEIN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lamp Brackets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a plan view of a lamp bracket showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof, the dominant feature of the design being shown in full lines therein.
