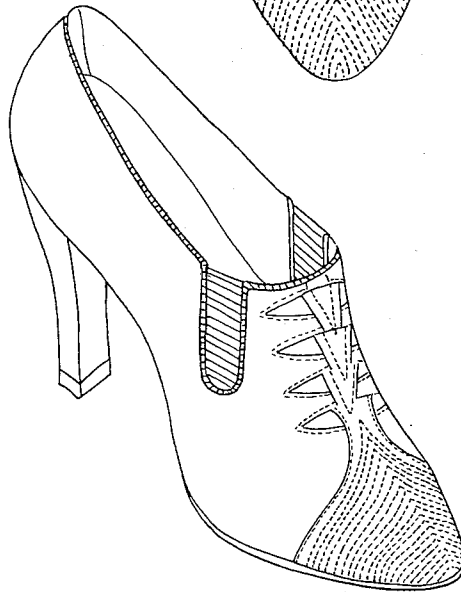
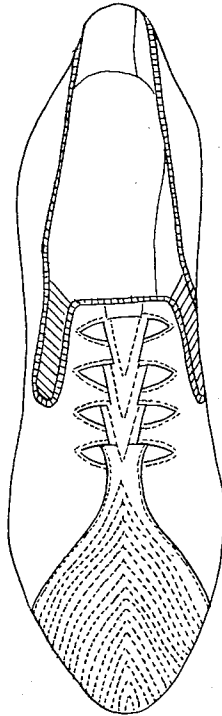

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HARRY GELLER, a citizen of the United States, and resident of New York city, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which,
