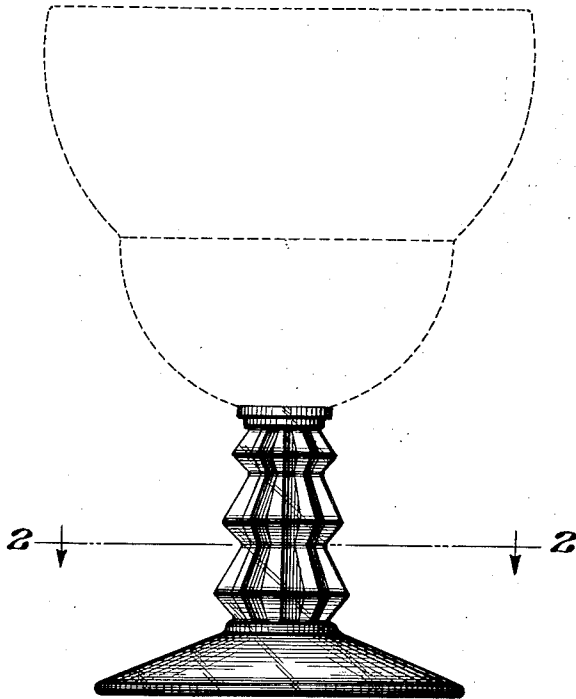
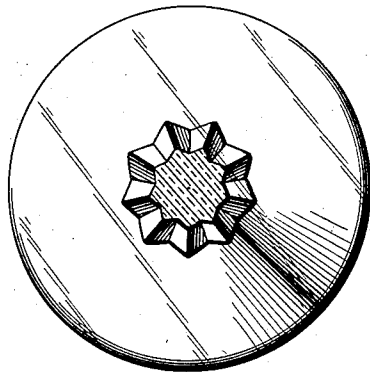

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Sakier, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Goblet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a goblet or similar article, showing my new design; and Figure 2 is a sectional view taken on line 2—2 of Fig. 1.
