
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handset component, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of a handset component showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; FIG. 6 is an enlarged right side view of FIG. 3 to show features of the design; and, FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective front view of FIG. 1 thereof. The broken line showing of the environmental structure of the handset in FIGS. 1-7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The sawtooth broken lines showing the border of the remainder of the handset in FIGS. 6 and 7 is for environmental purposes only and is used for the enlarged views. The change in contrast in shading represents a change in color or material.














