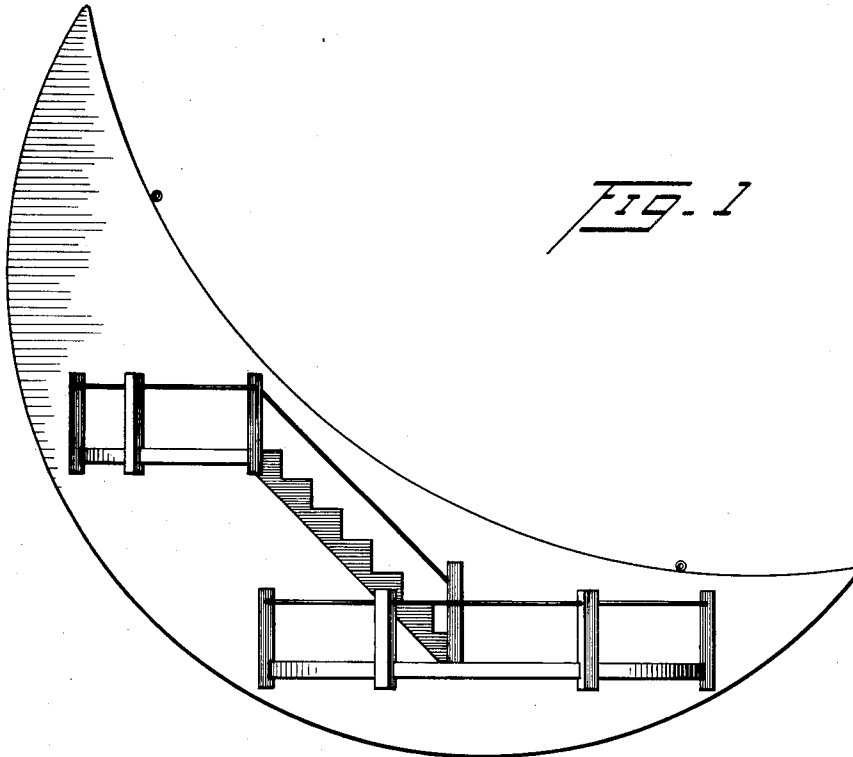
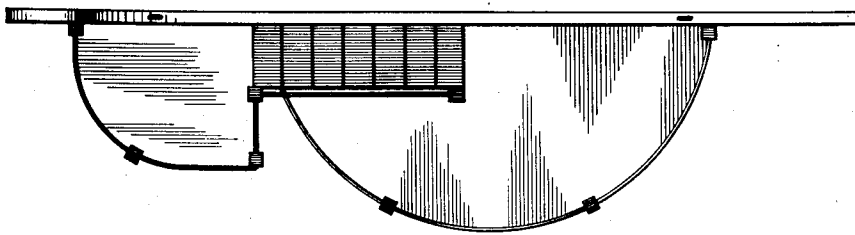

## DESIGN FOR A WHATNOT

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Henry G.
