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HIGH INTENSITY CLIP LAMP

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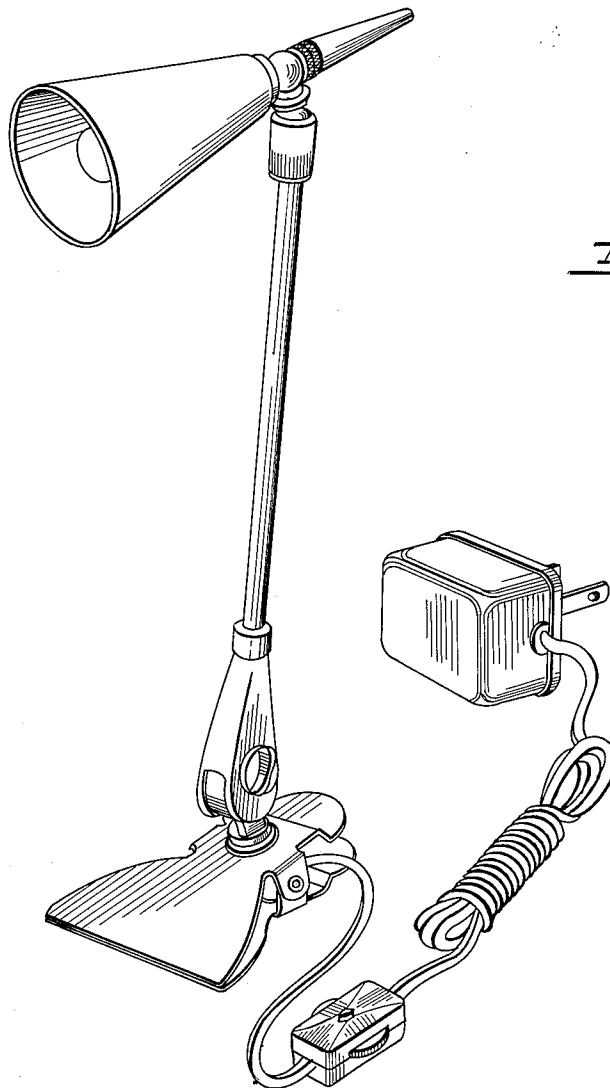

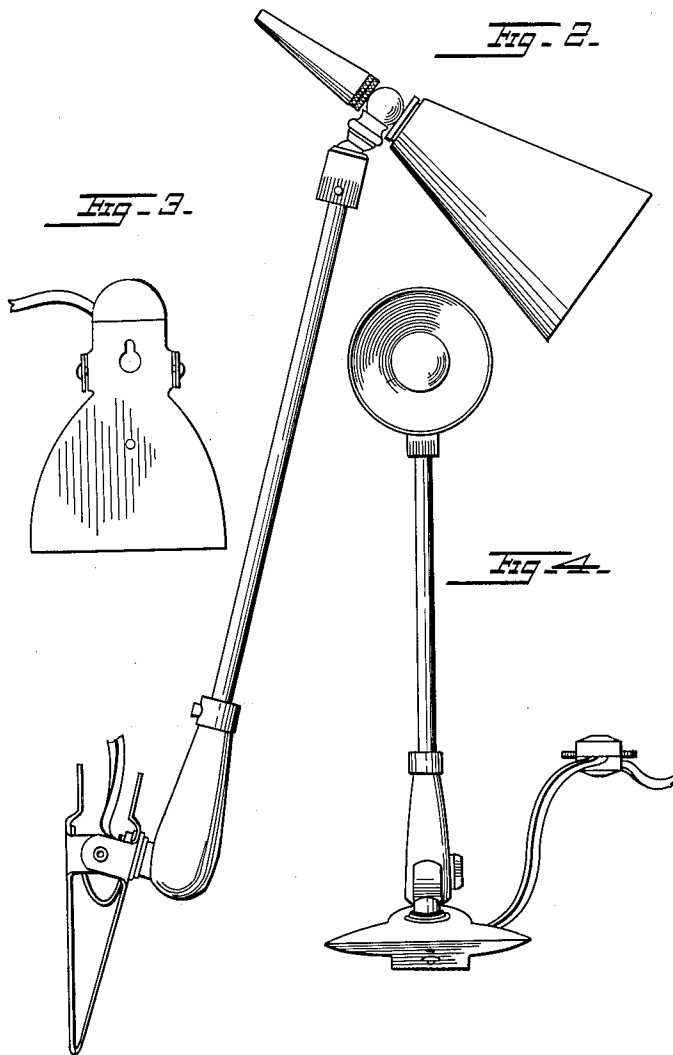


FIGURE 1 is a perspective view of the high intensity clip lamp with the transformer and hanger bracket therefor,

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the high intensity clip lamp and hanger bracket therefor,

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary bottom plan view thereof, and

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary front elevational view thereof.

The rear of the transformer is flat and unornamented except for two protruding prongs, and the undisclosed sides and ends are the same except for the omission of the cord. The undisclosed sides of the shade, support and clamp are the same in appearance as the sides shown.
