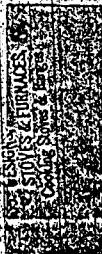

Daniel F Goodhue and Charles Guild of Cincinnati, Ohio.
Letters Patent. No 252. Dated Dec 4, 1849.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we Daniel F Goodhue and Charles Guild of Cincinnati, Hamilton Co, Ohio. have invented or produced a new ornamental Design for Stoves, and we do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the annexed drawings making a part of this specification.

The stove is of what is called The Premium form, having the oven back of and somewhat Elevated with respect to the fire chamber.

(Fig 1) exhibits in Perspective the general configuration of the stove.

All the Doors are bordered with the same series of mouldings. (a. fig 2, a' fig 3, and a" fig 4).

(Fig 2) represents the oven Door. The ornamental work (b) on its panel, consists of two cornucopias containing flowers, interspersed with scroll work. The situation of this door is indicated by outline at (t fig 1).

Fig 3. represents the ornamental panel (b') and a portion of the moulding (a') of the front fire doors. The situation of these doors is indicated by outline at (u w fig 1).

(Fig 4) represents the ornamental panel (b'') and a portion of the moulding (a'') of the end fire door. The situation of this door is indicated by outline at (v fig 1).

Fig 5. represents the upper front corner of the side plate with the ornament (c) thereupon. (m fig 1) indicates the position of this ornament.

(Fig 6) represents a portion of the side plate over

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the oven door with the ornament (d) thereupon. (N fig 1) indicates the position of this ornament

(Fig 7) represents the upper back corner of the side plate with the ornament (e) thereupon. (O fig 1) indicates the position of this ornament.

Fig 8, represents the back plate with its centre occupied by a scroll ornament (f) and the four corners of the same panel occupied by the ornaments (g) and with the side panels (h) aside the foregoing panels, ornamented as at (i). The panels (h' fig 1) have the same ornament.

(j fig 9) is a section of the moulding around the edges of the top plate. (k fig 9) is a section of the moulding around the edges of the side plates.

Fig 10, is a section of the moulding around the doors. The moulding around the hearth plate is similar to that around the top plate.

Having thus fully described and represented the configuration and decorations of our ornamental Design for a Cooking Stove, what we claim as our design or production, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the particular configuration of mouldings around the edge of the doors, and the ornaments on their panels. We also claim the external plates of the stove ornamented substantially as described and illustrated in the accompanying drawings. We also claim the ornamental pattern of leg as shown.
