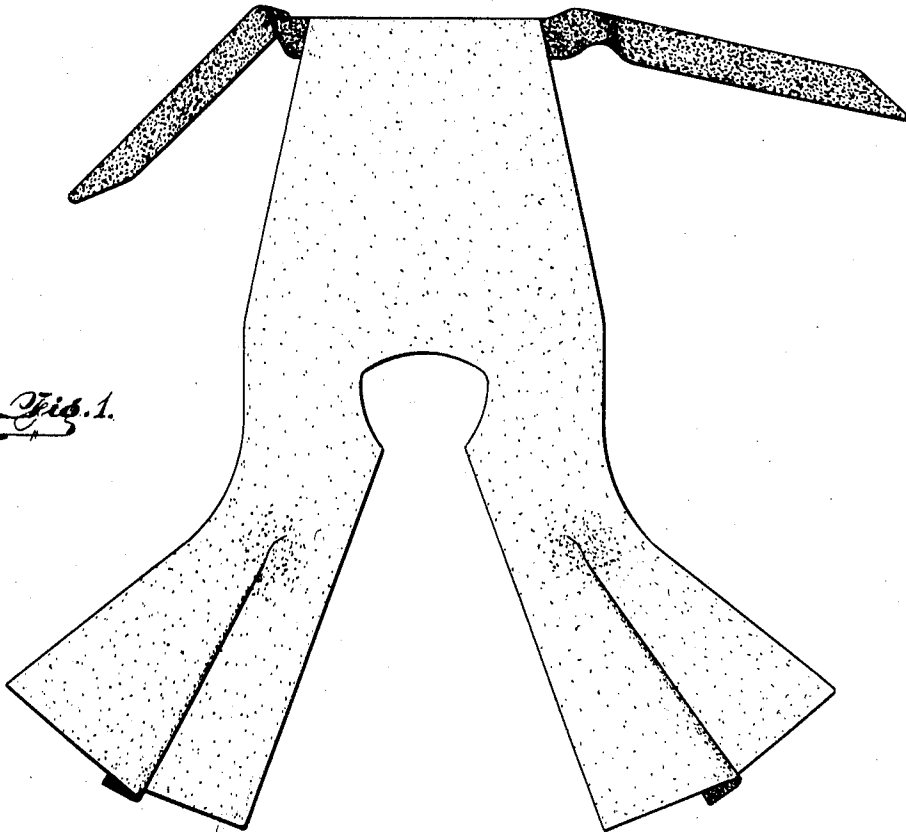

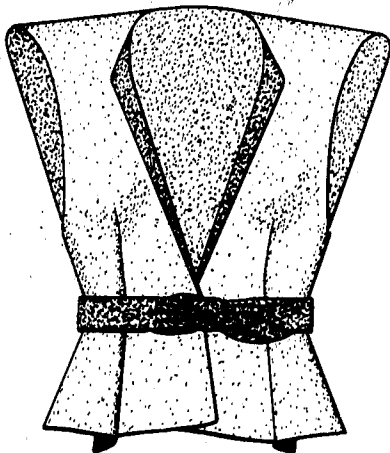

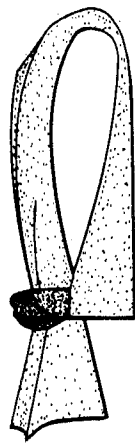

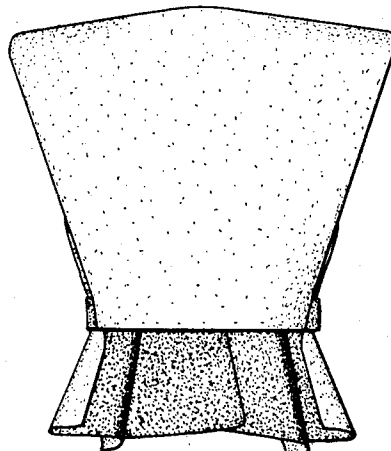


Fig. 4. INVENTOR.

DESIGN FOR A VESTEE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Helene Pons, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vestee, of which the following is a specification; reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a vestee, showing my new design, and in flat open condition.

Fig. 2 is a front view thereof, as worn on the person.

Fig. 3 is a side view of the vestee as shown in Fig. 2.

Fig. 4 is a back view of the vestee shown in Fig. 2.
