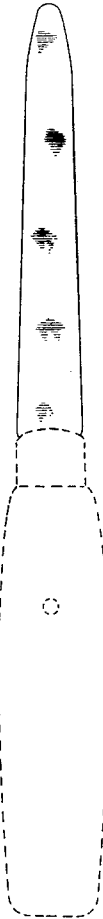

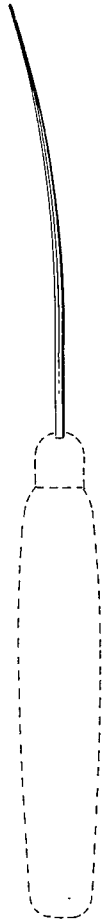

*To all whom it may concern:*
