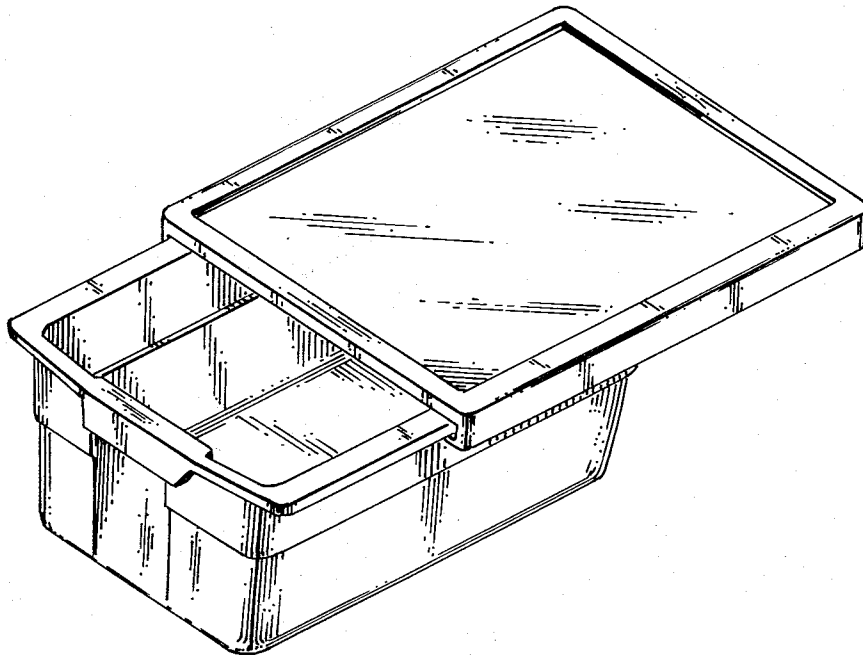

The ornamental design for a child's lap desk and blackboard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a child's lap desk and blackboard showing my new design.
 FIG. 2 is an end elevational view.
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view; and
 FIG. 4 is a perspective view showing the top partly open to give access to the interior storage compartment.
 The side and end not shown are the same as those shown.



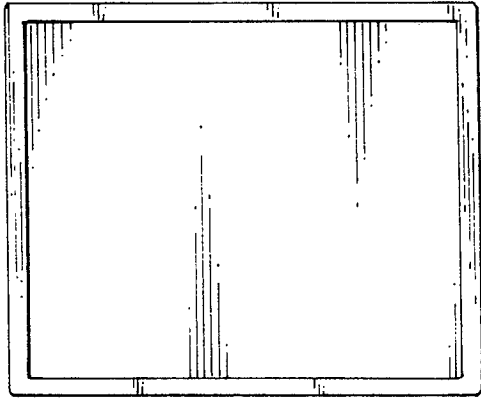

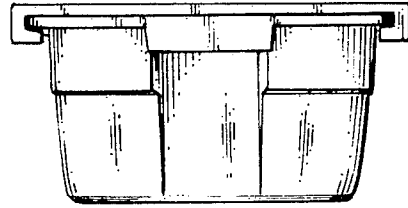

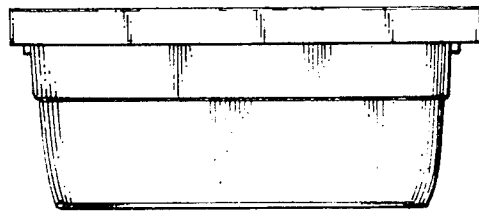

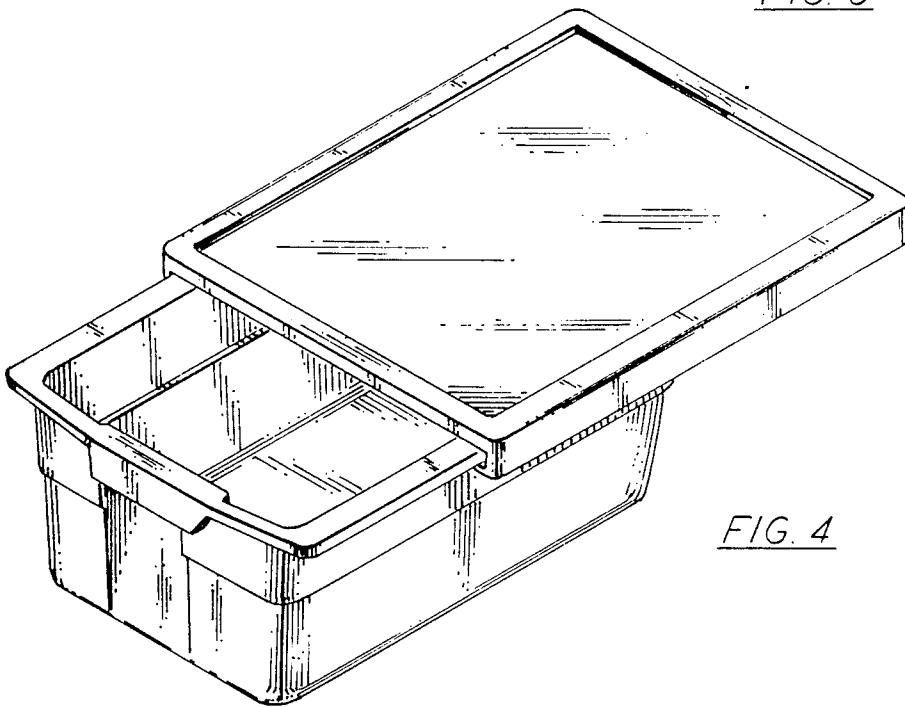
