FIG. 4 represents a right side view of the card reading and writing apparatus of the present invention;

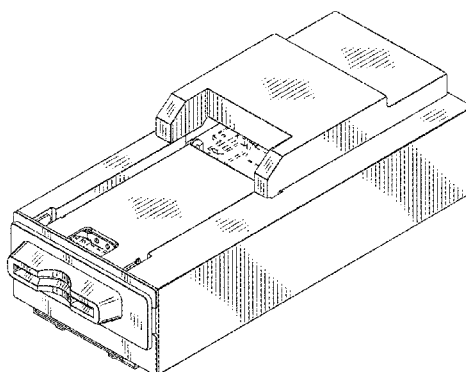
FIG. 5 represents a left side view of the card reading and writing apparatus of the present invention;

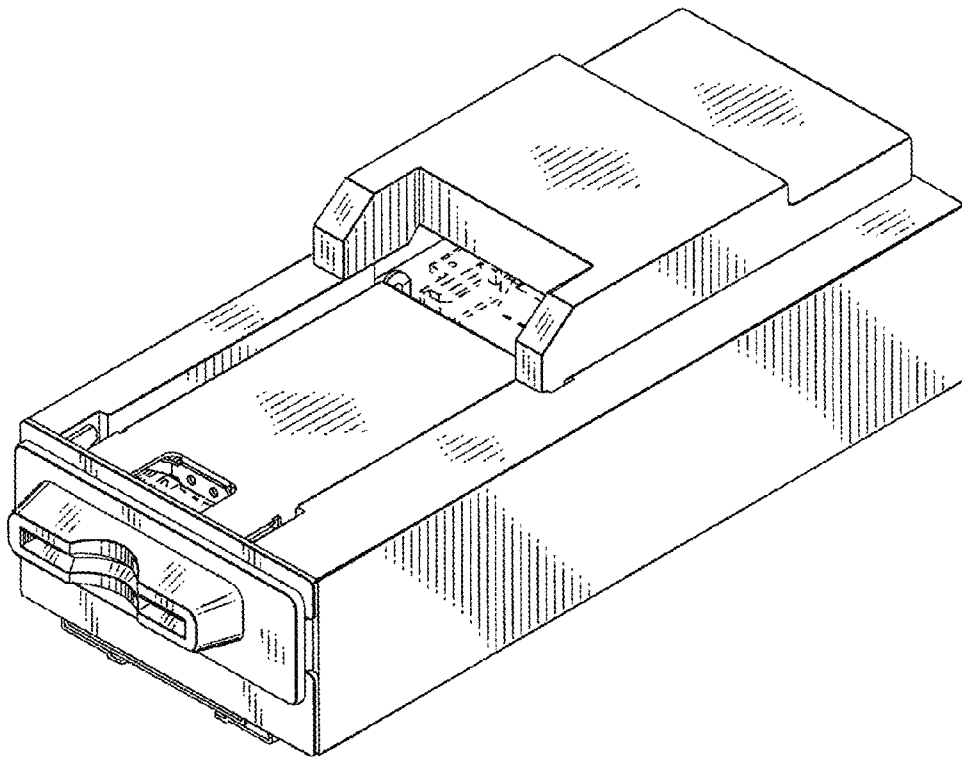

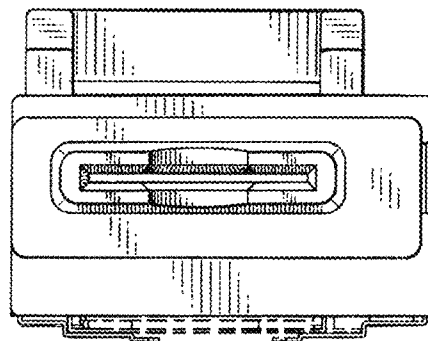

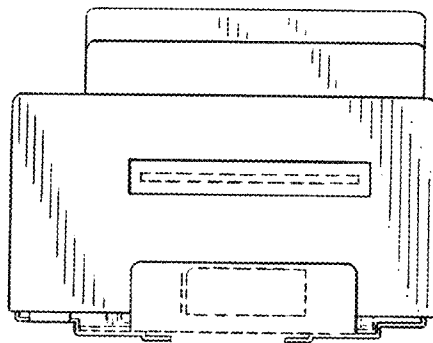

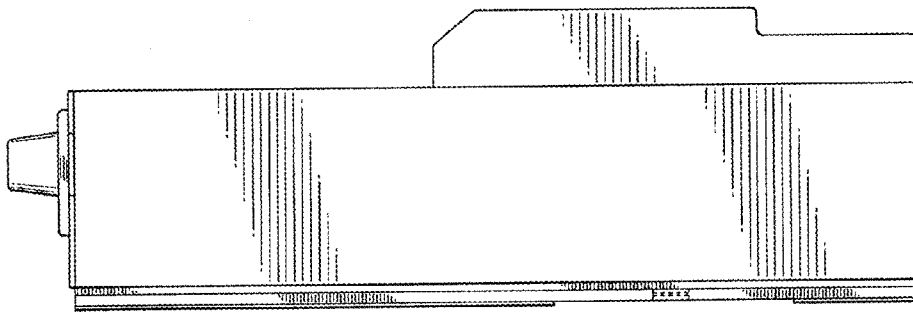

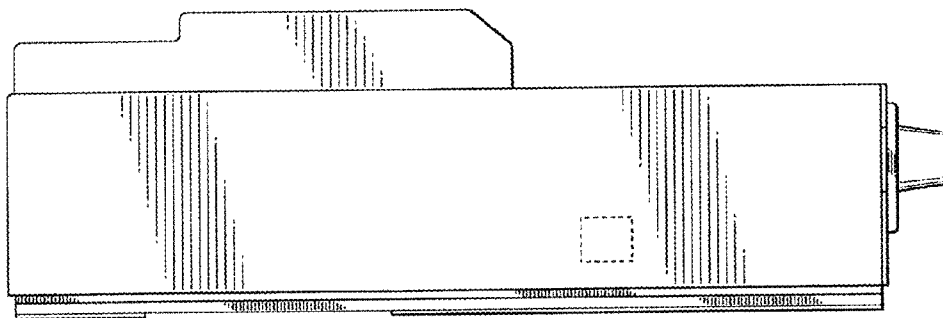

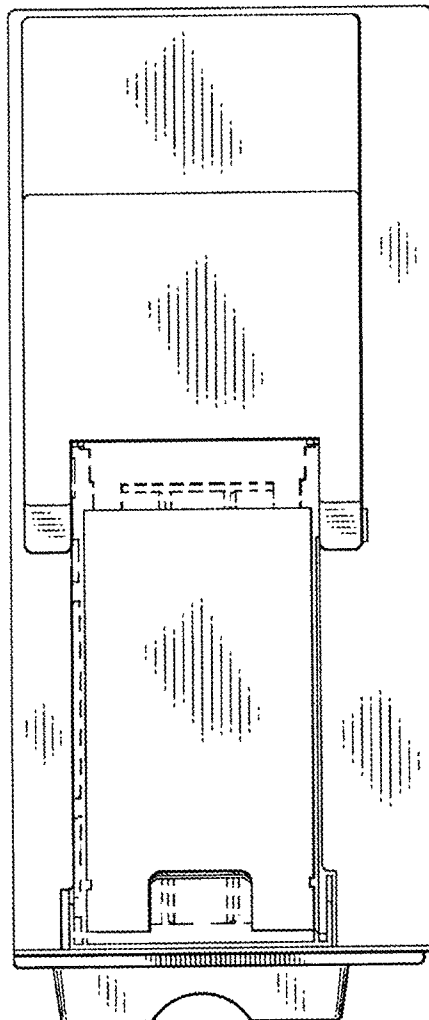
