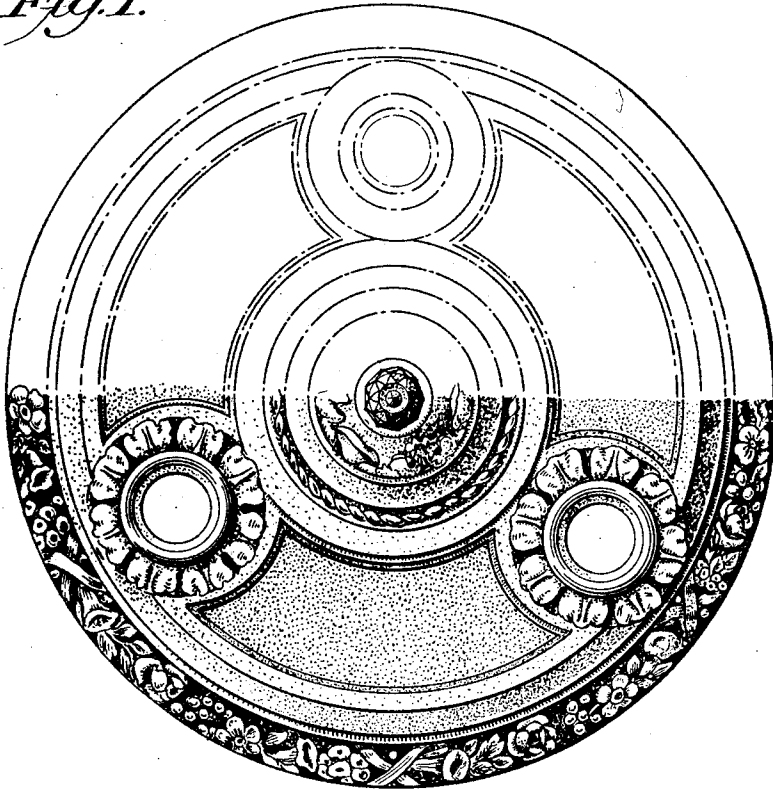
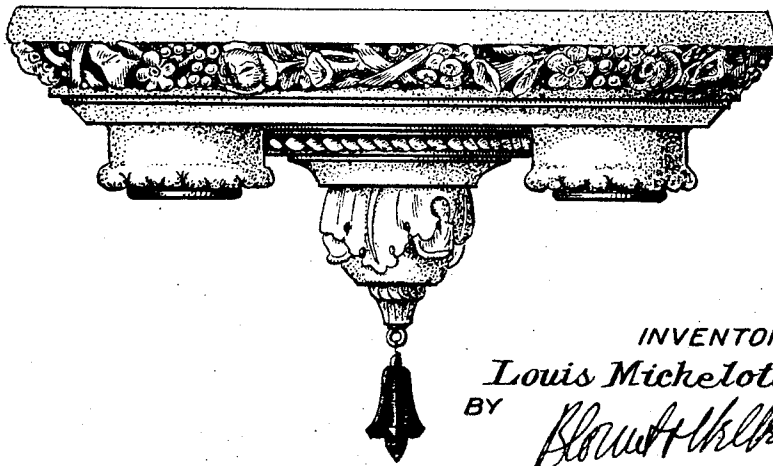

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING FIXTURE.

Application filed June 19, 1925. Serial No. 13,823. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOUIS MICHELOTTI, a citizen of the United States, residing in Philadelphia, county of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lighting Fixture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a bottom plan

view, only a portion of the ornamental surface being completed, it being understood that the remaining portion involves a mere repetition of the completed portion, and Fig. 2 is a side elevation of a lighting fixture, showing my new design.
