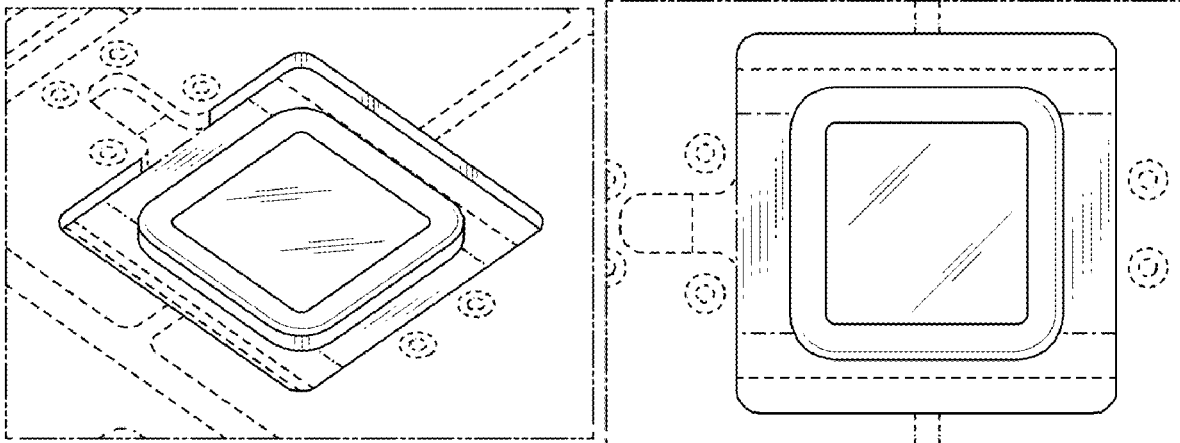
The ornamental design for a light emitting diode, as shown and described.

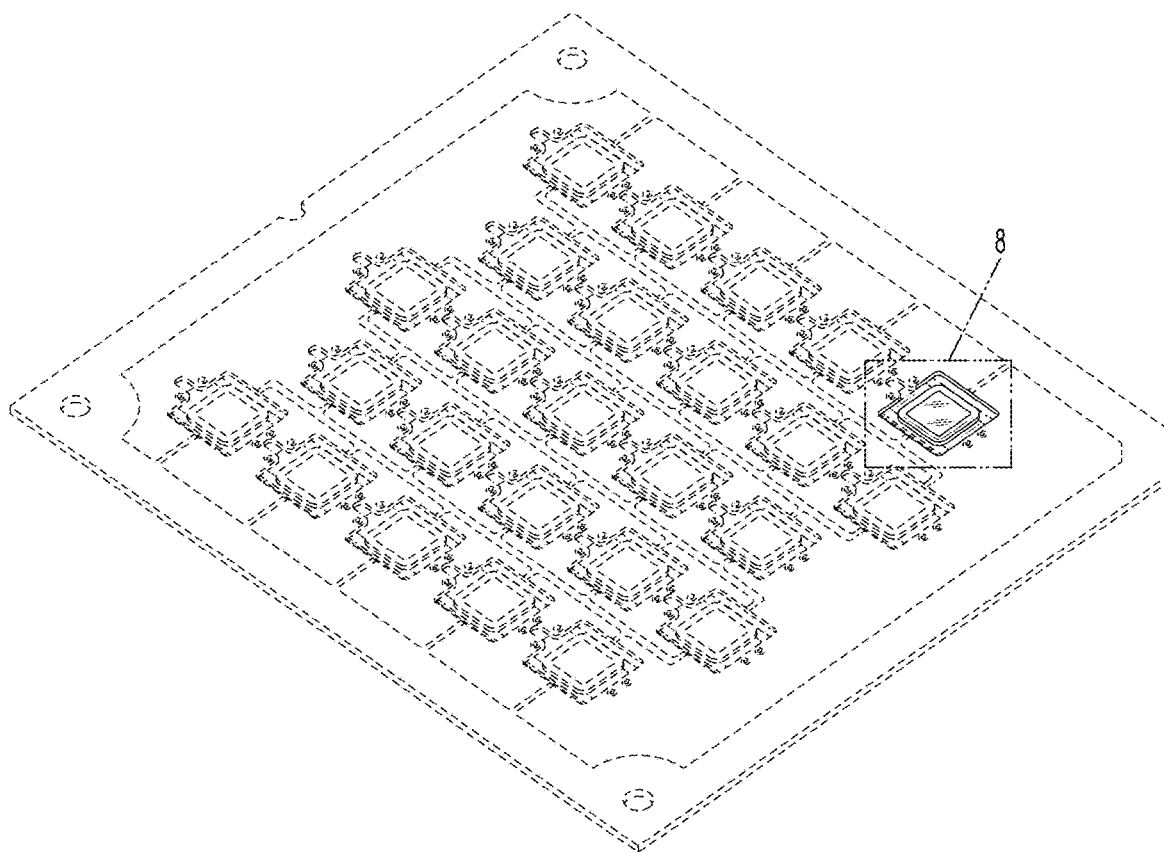

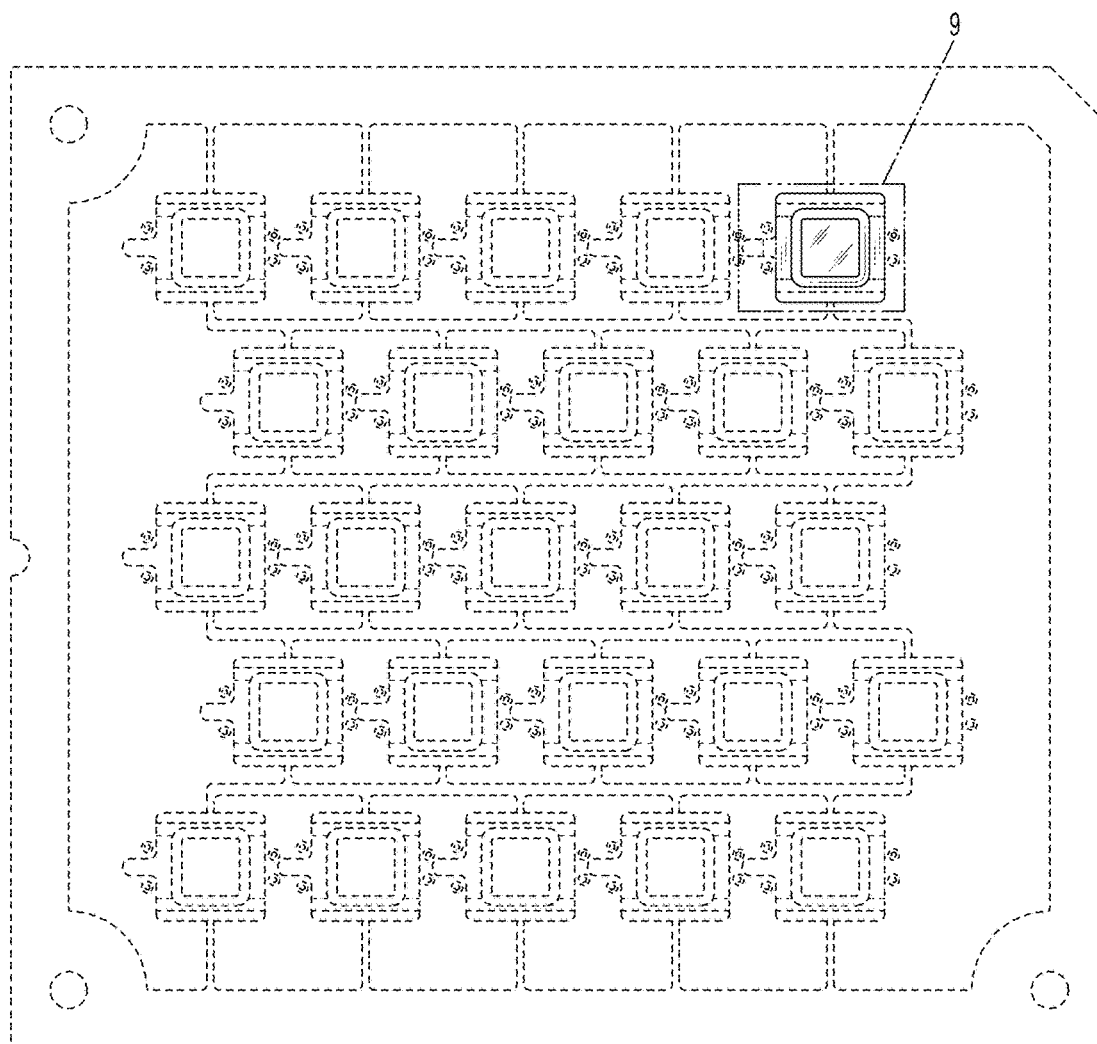

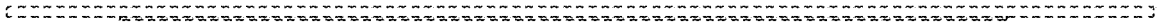

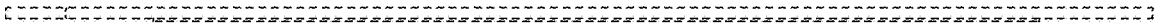

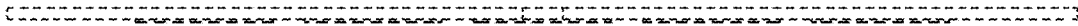

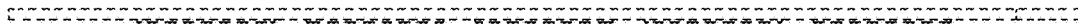

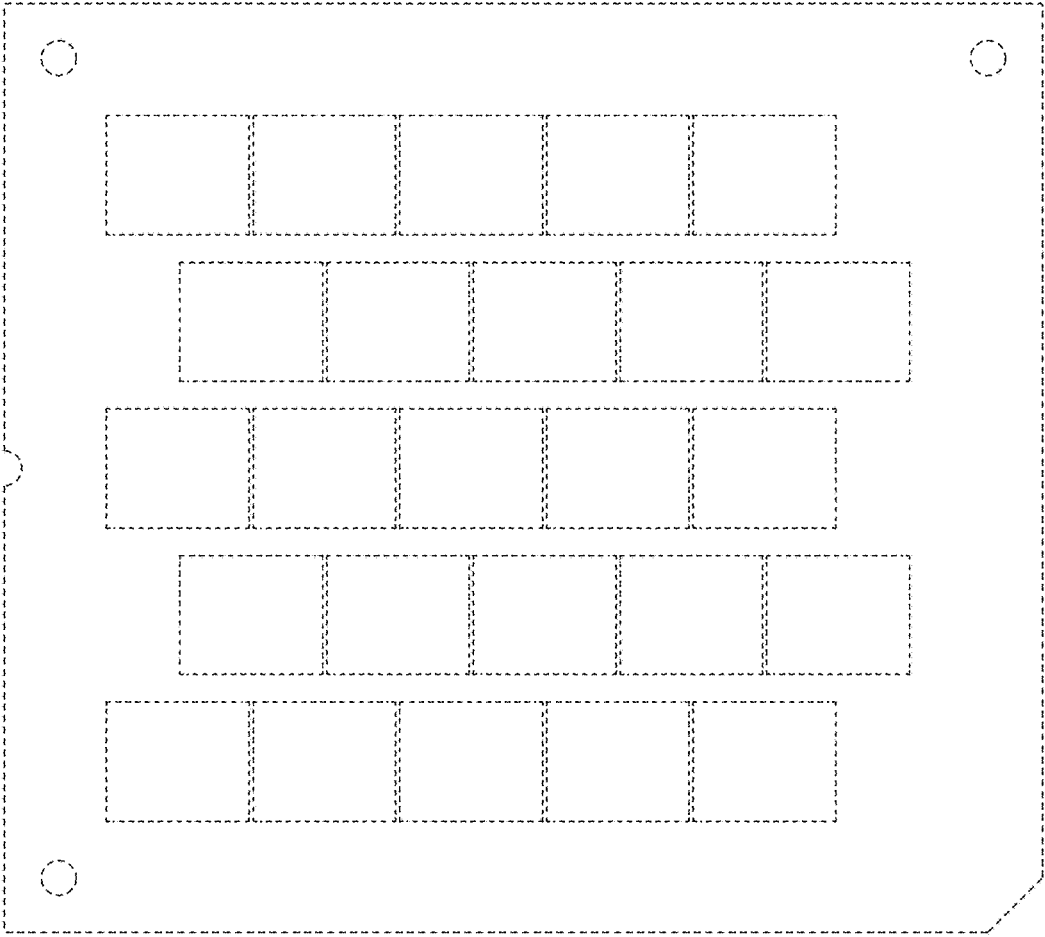

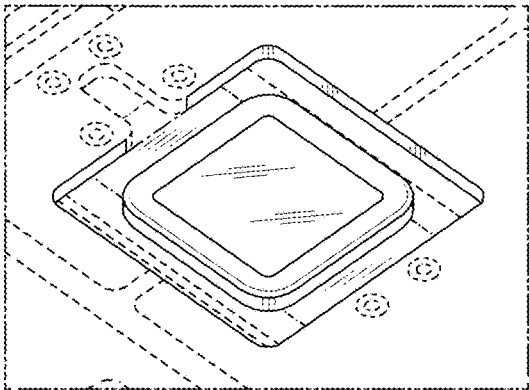

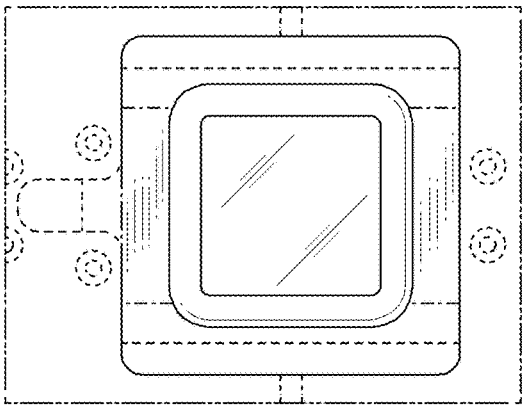
