The ornamental design for a combined tape player and radio tuner, as shown and described.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

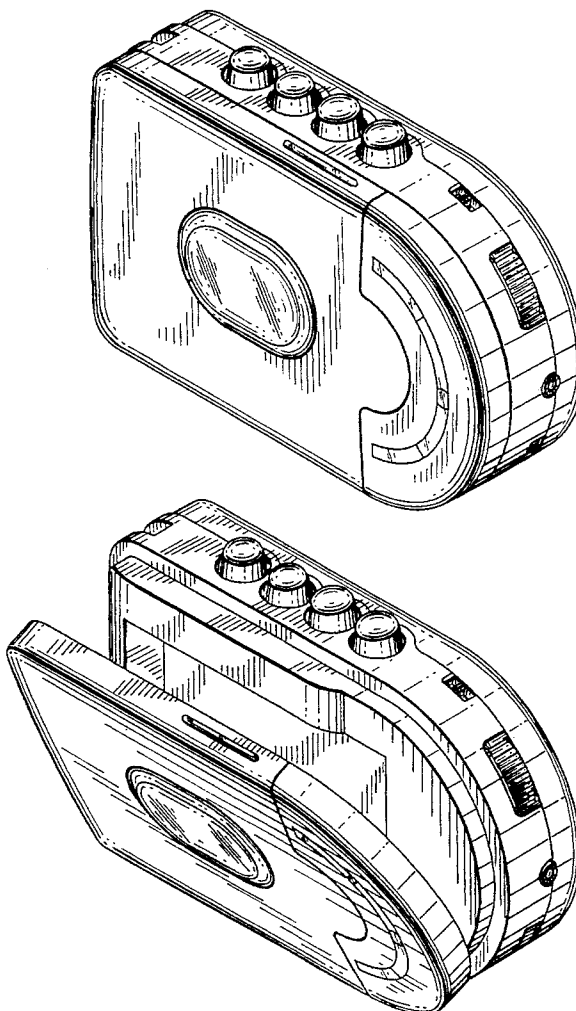
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

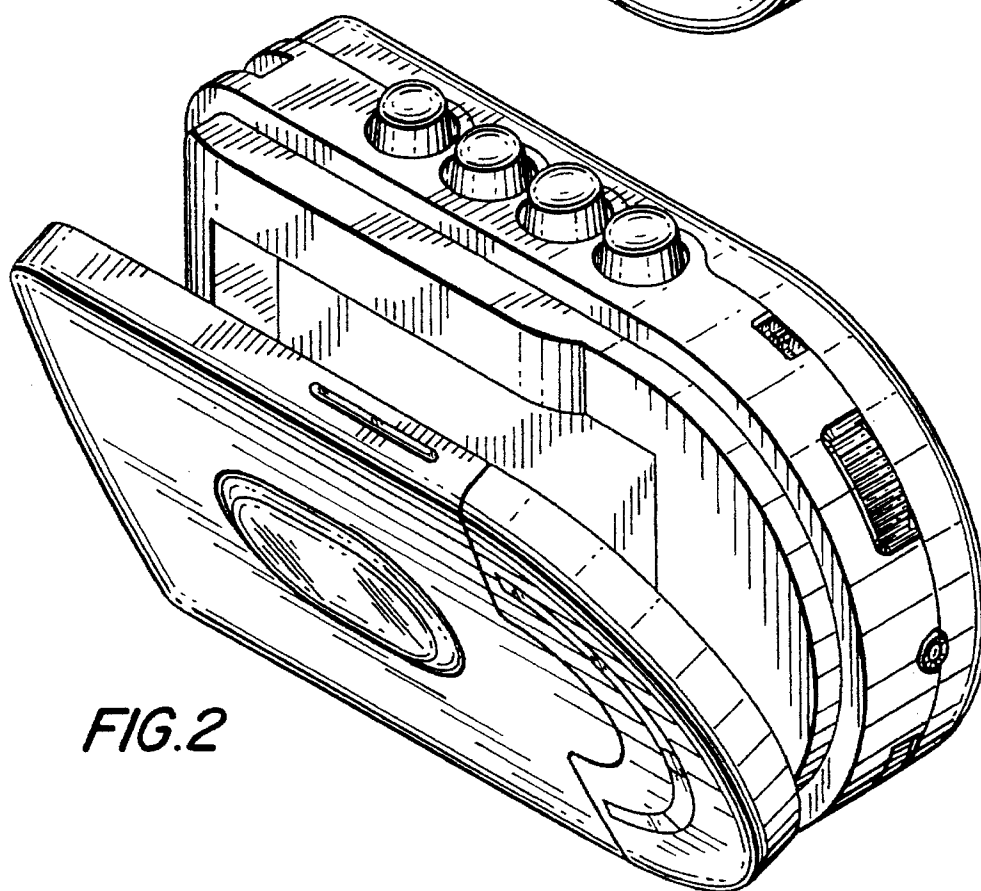
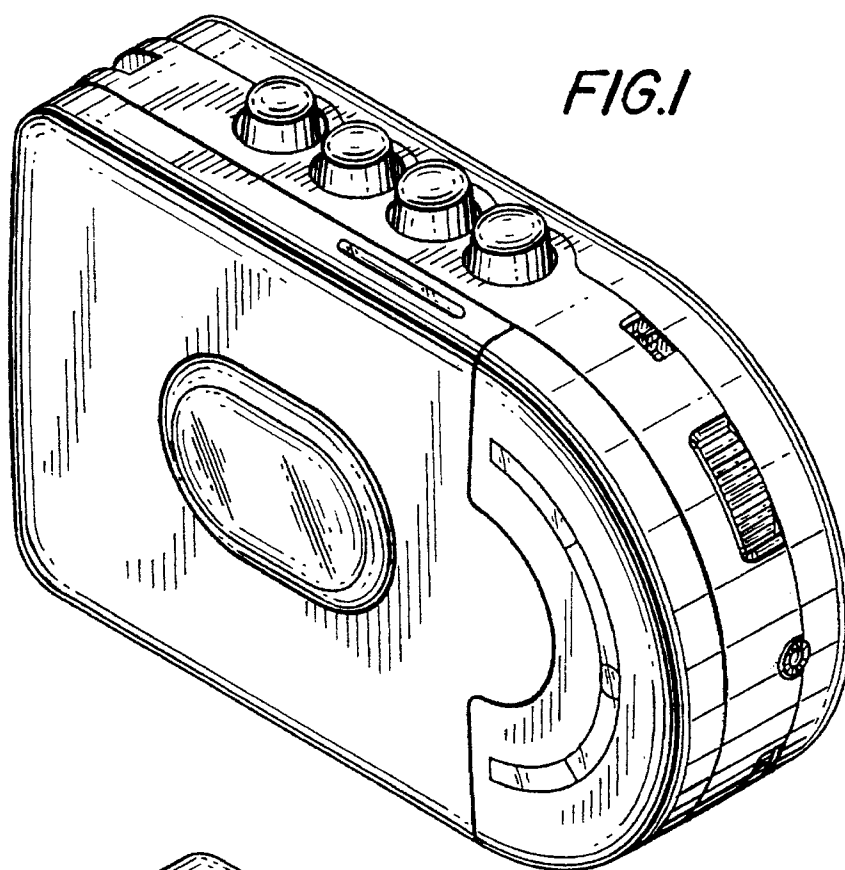

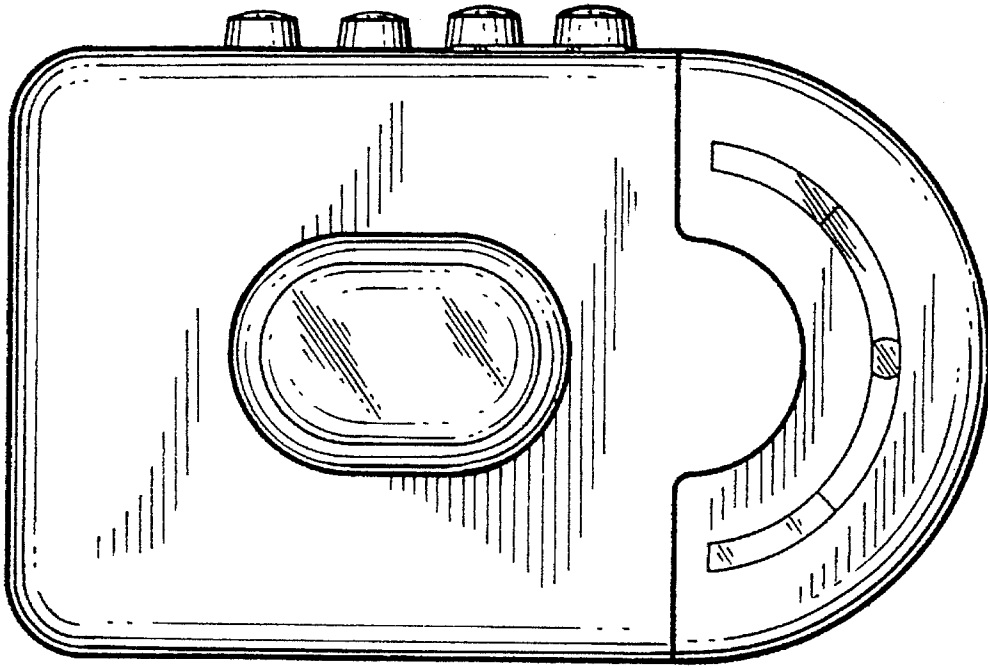
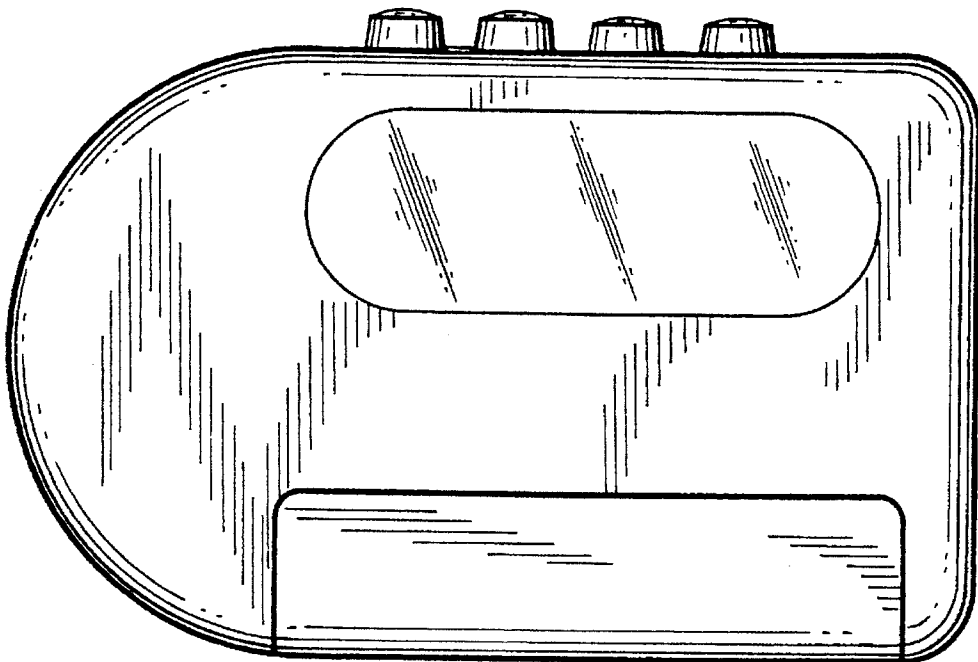

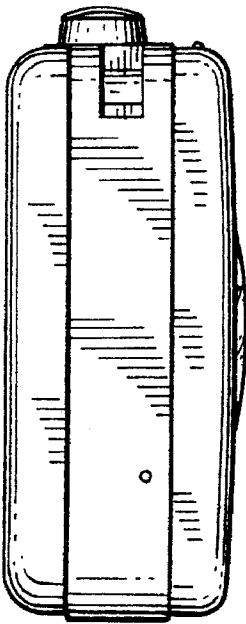

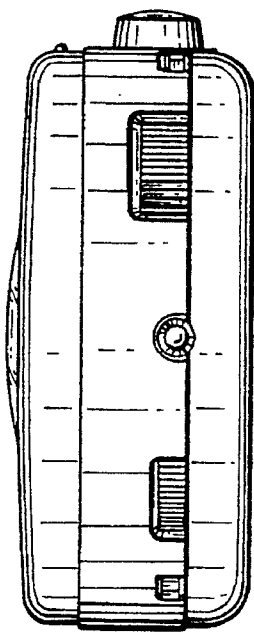

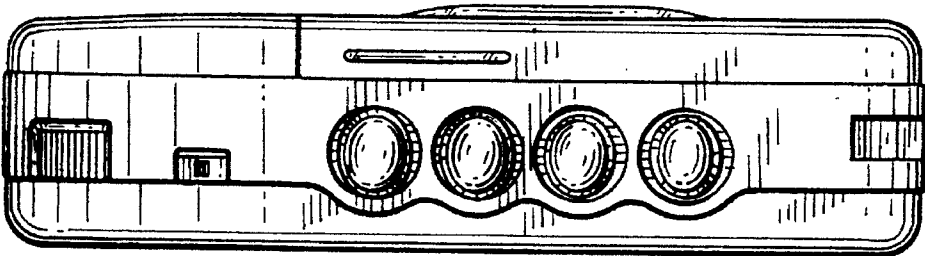
