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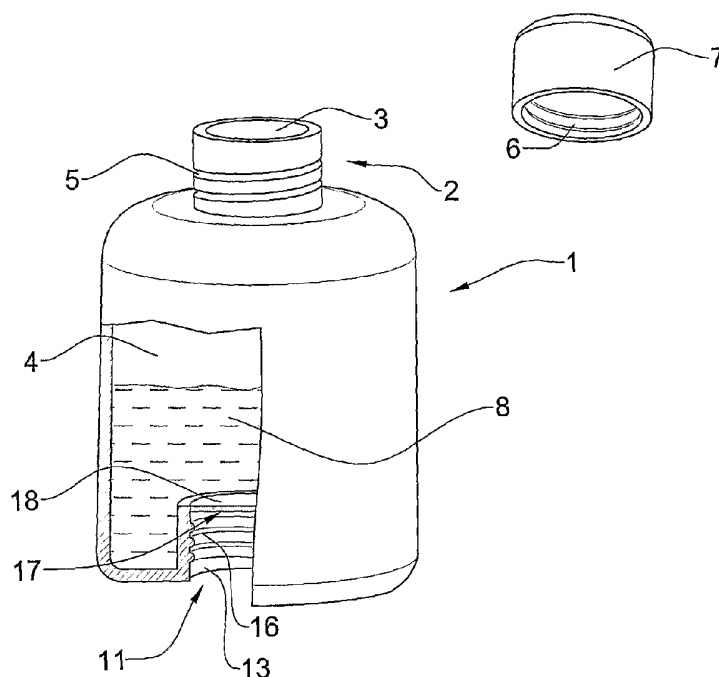

(54) Title: CONTAINER



(57) Abstract: The invention provides a first container (1) for flowable substances. The container (1) has a first opening (11) provided with a plug or seal (18). The plug or seal (18) is configured to be brought from its closed state to its open state after a fluid tight seal has been formed between the first opening (11) and a second opening of a second container (1'). The plug or seal (18) remains attached to the first container (1) when the plug (18) is brought from its closed state to its open state.

Claims Nos.: 24,25

Claims 24 and 25 do not define any structural features of a container or an adaptor and thus the subject-matter of claims 24 and 25 is unclear (Article 6 PCT). Therefore, it is not possible to carry out a search covering said devices.
