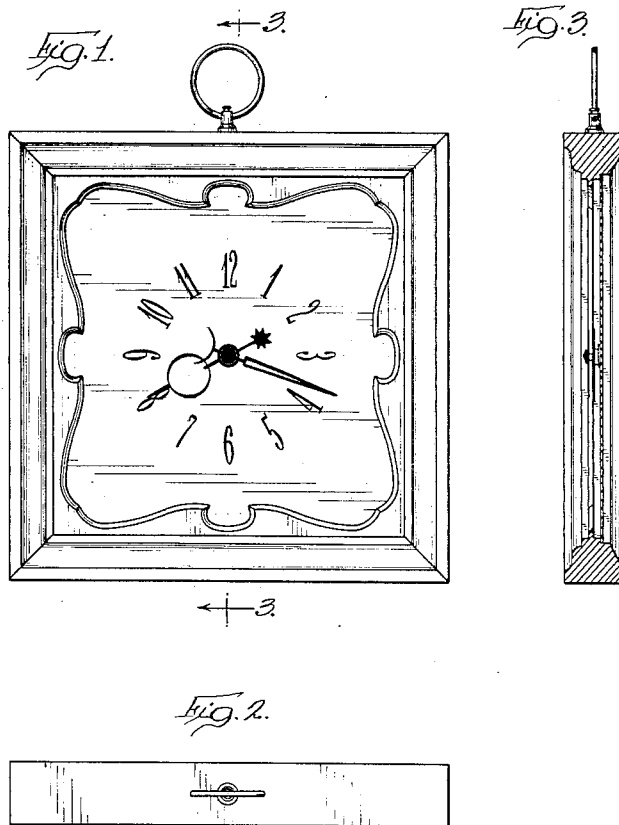


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock embodying our new design;
