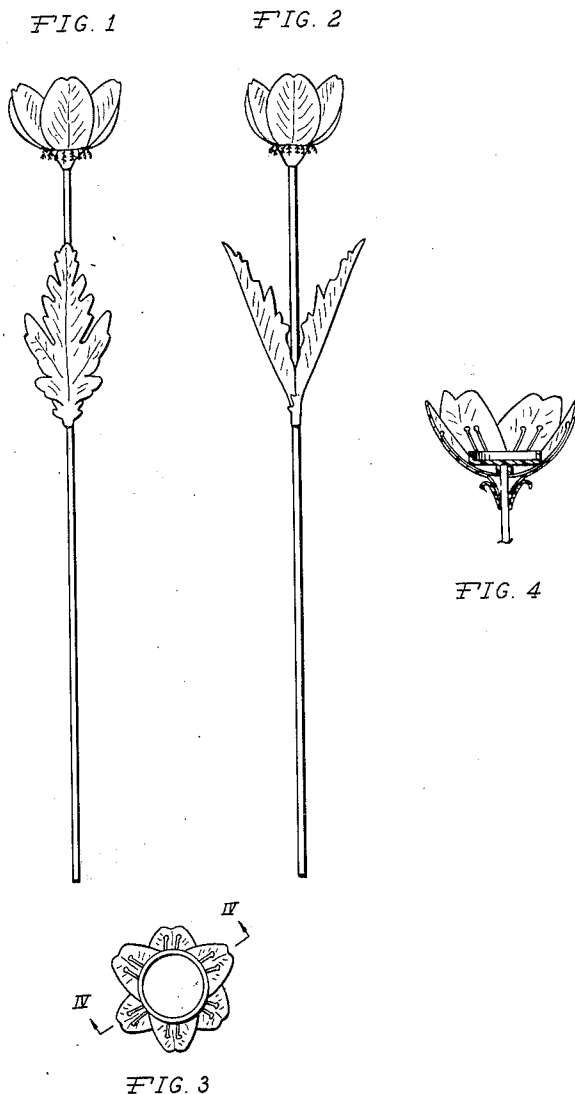


FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a portable lawn stand for a tumber or the like embodying my new design.
