

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a simulative toy vehicle or similar article, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a simulative toy vehicle or similar article showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.










