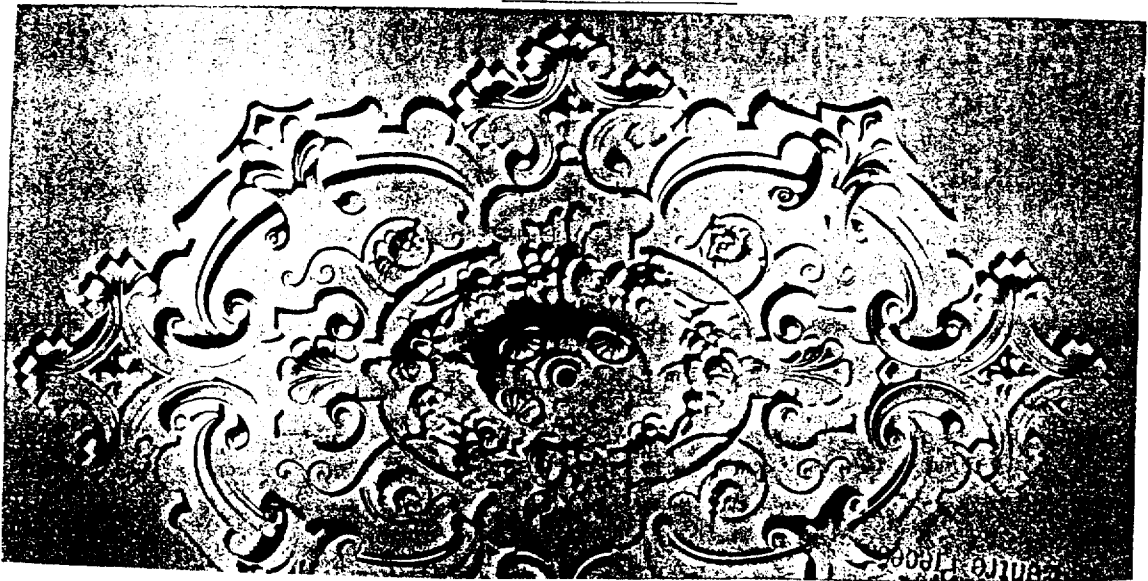

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY BERGER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Center-Piece; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable those skilled in the art to carry out the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part of this specification, which drawing shows a face view of this design.

This invention consists in the design of a central button surrounded by an oval wreath of foliage, outside of which are ornamental shields and scroll-work, inclosed by an elongated rim of segmental bars, ornamented by a scroll supporting a spread leaf, and between each two of which bars is a spear-head escutcheon.

In the drawing, the letter A designates the central button of my design, which is of an oval shape, and is ornamented by sunken shells *a*. B is an oval wreath of interspersed leaves and flowers, which surrounds the but-

ton A, and is surrounded by ornamental tracery or scroll-work, composed chiefly of shields C. D are segmental bars, which, together with the spear-head escutcheons E, form the rim of my design, the whole being of an oblong oval shape or outline. The bars D are ornamented with a scroll, F, on which is a leaf, *b*, in a spread condition.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The combination of the oval wreath B and shields C with the central button A, as shown and described.

2. The segmental bars D and escutcheons E, in combination with the shields C, oval wreath B, and central button A, as shown and specified.
