

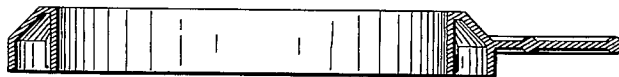
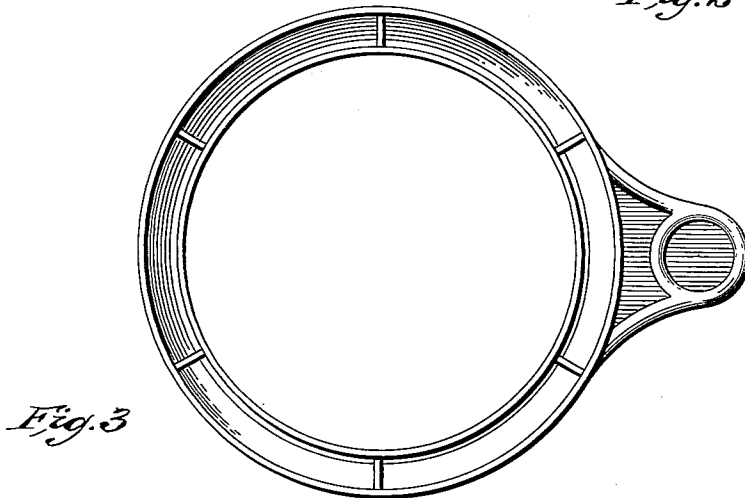
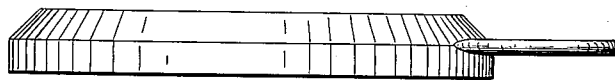
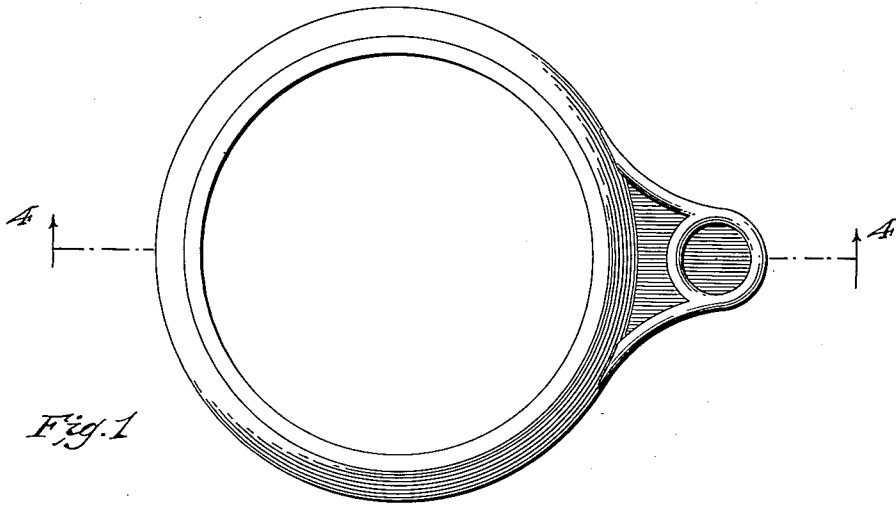

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George W. Thorward, a citizen of the United States, residing at Caldwell, county of Essex, State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hamburger Mold or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a hamburger mold or similar article, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

Fig. 4 is a vertical cross-sectional view of the same taken on line 4—4 in Fig. 1.

The ornamental design for a hamburger mold or similar article, as shown.
