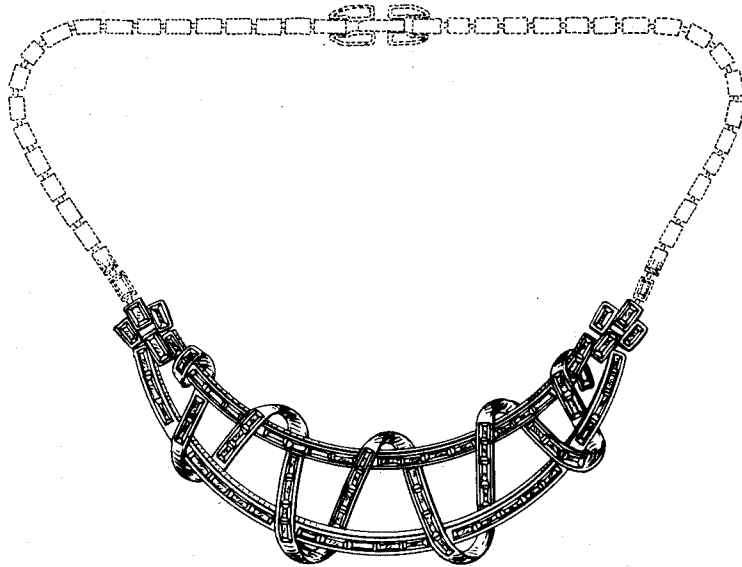
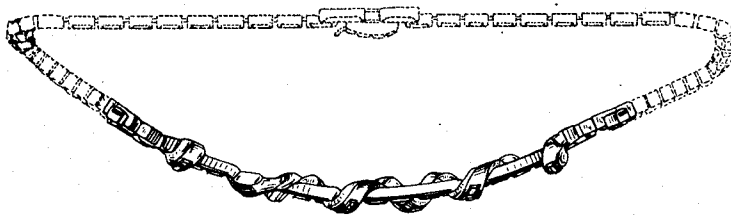

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Marcel Boucher, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Eltingville, in the county of Richmond and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Necklace or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a necklace or similar article, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top view of the same.

The dominant features of my design reside in those portions shown in full lines.
