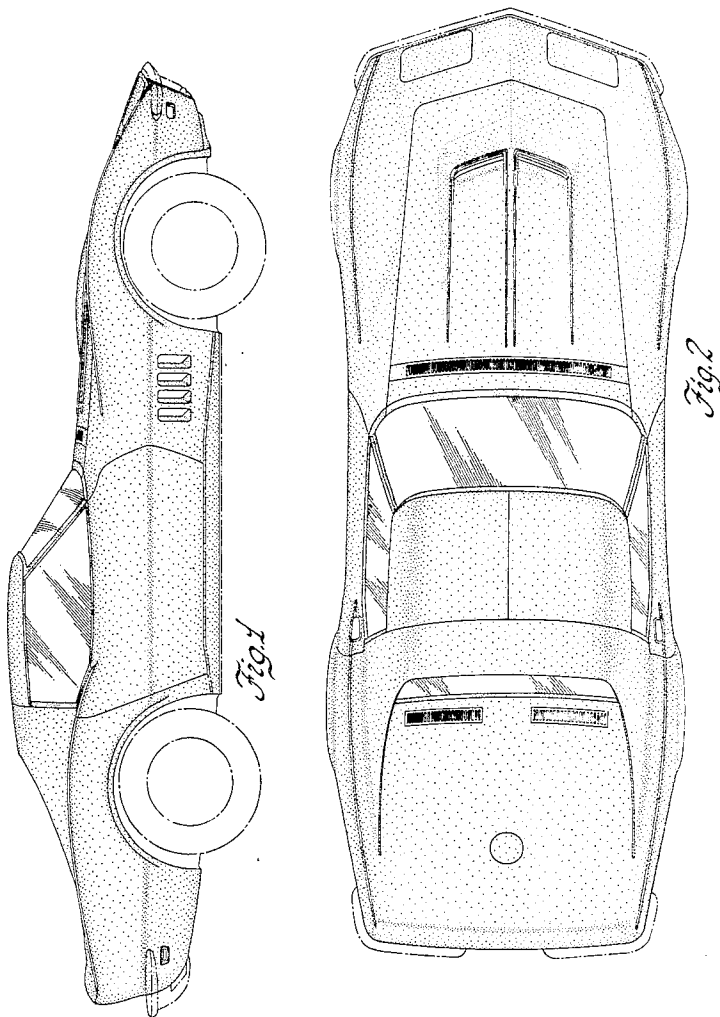

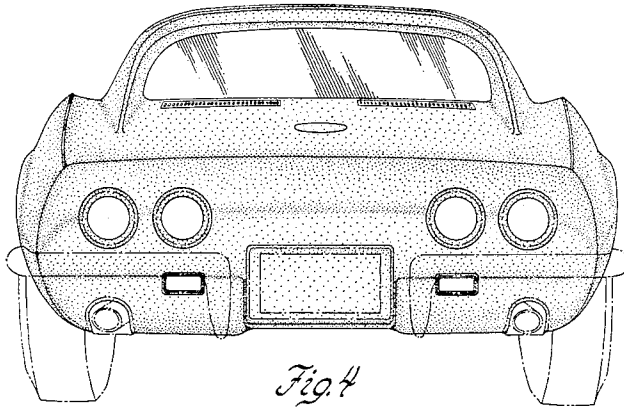
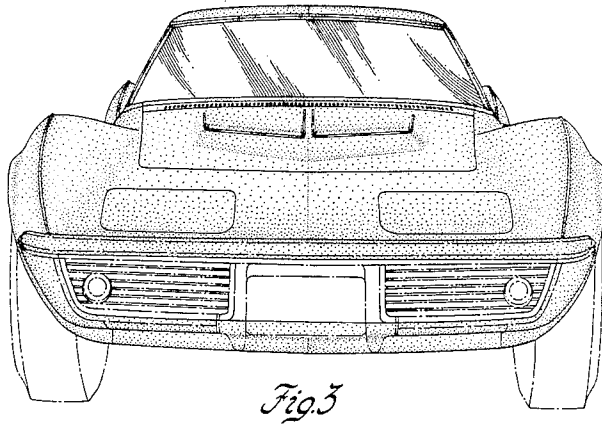


FIGURE 1 is a side elevational view of an automobile showing my new design;
