The ornamental design for a protective cover for play gym leg joints, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a protective cover for play gym leg joints showing our new design;

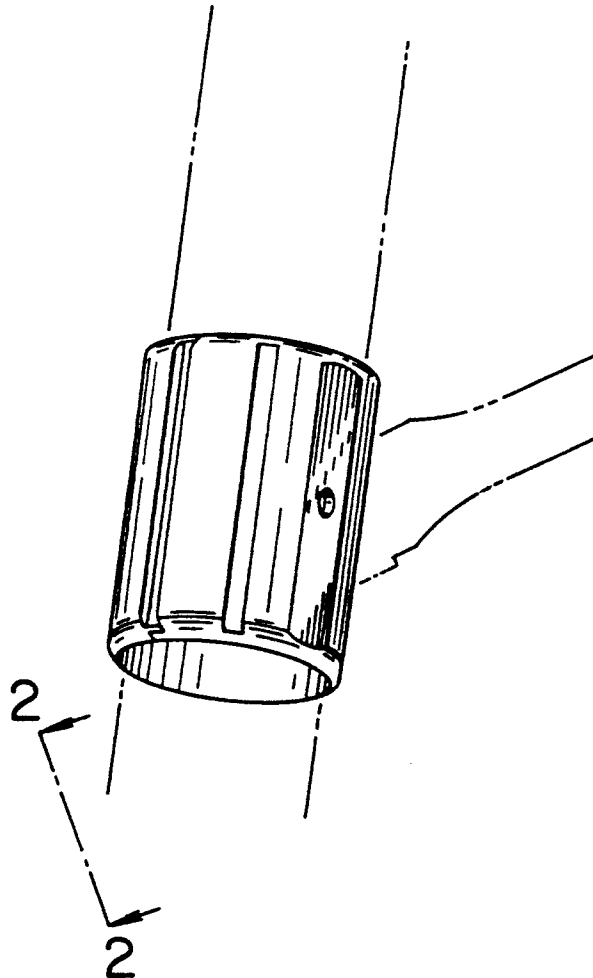
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof; shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

The broken line showing of the legs for a play gym is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claim.



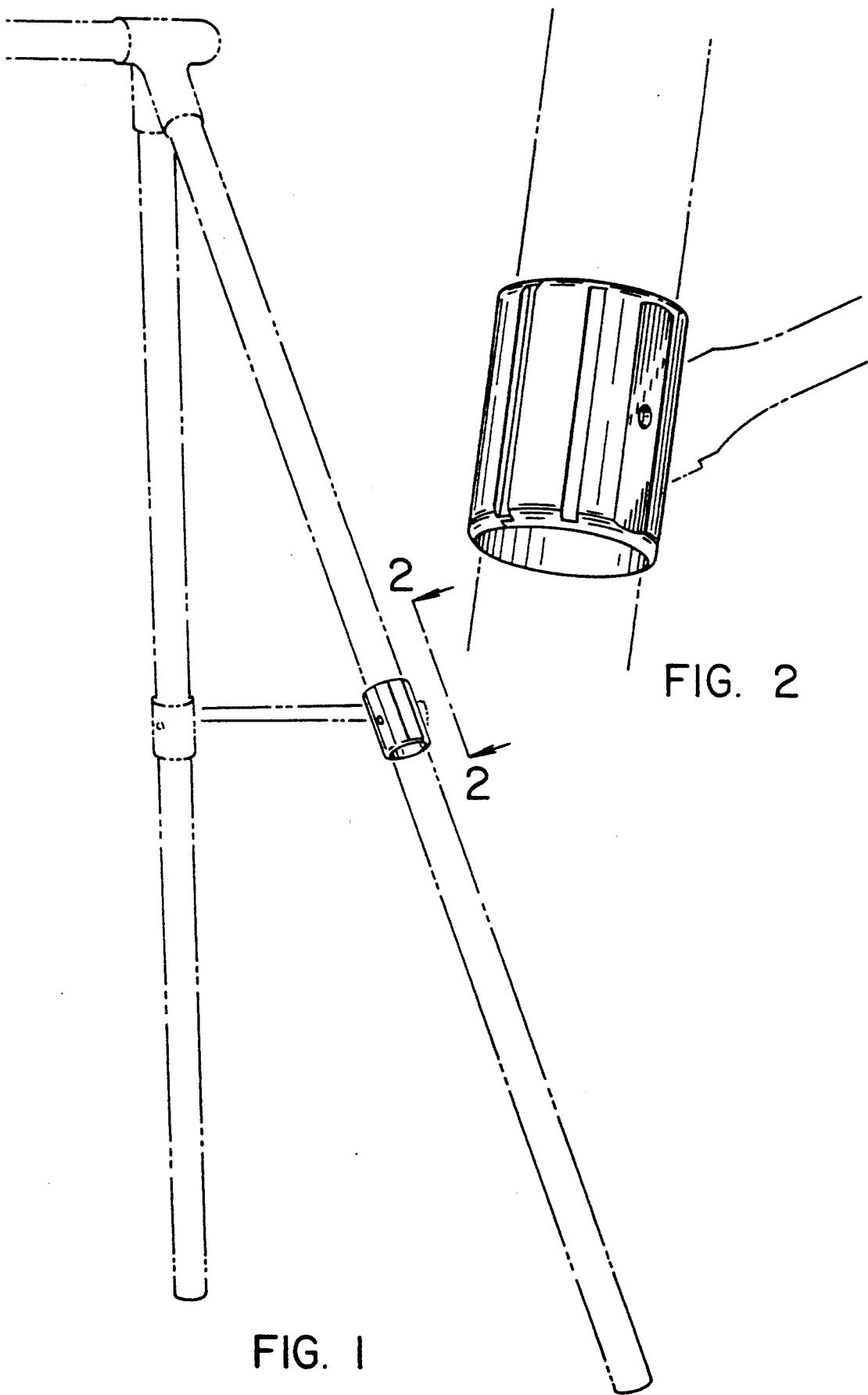

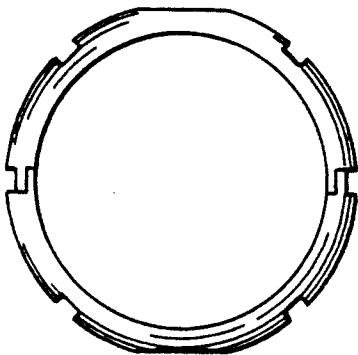

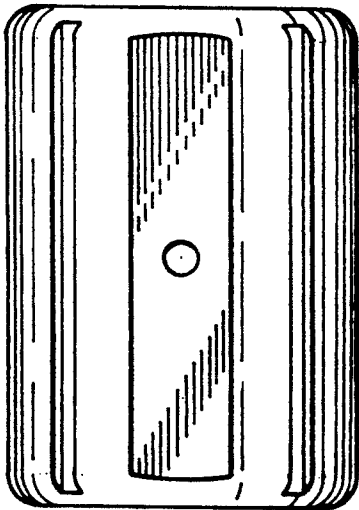
