

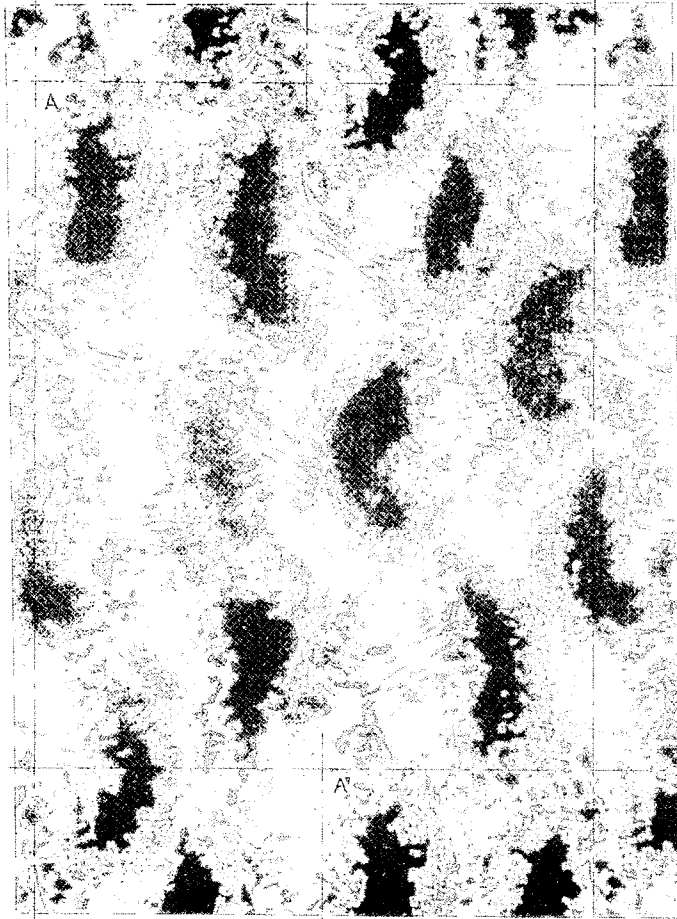

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert E. Fatherley, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Darien, Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric

showing my new design. The dot and dash lines on the drawing show the design unit, which unit is repeated in staggered succession, as indicated by the angles A and A'.
